Parking and driving on campus are at the students' and guests' own risk, and the school is not responsible for vehicle damage. Providing parking is a privilege; all students must adhere to the following regulations and guidelines to maintain safety and order.



Parking and Traffic Flow

Students must use the designated student parking lot. Traffic flow patterns must be followed, and the maximum speed limit of 5 MPH must be observed at all times within the parking lot.



Reckless Driving and Loitering

Students who violate traffic rules or drive recklessly may be suspended or banned from driving on campus. Loitering in parking areas and visiting them during the school day are prohibited.



Registration and Permits

All vehicles must be registered with the front office and display a parking permit at all times on campus. Failure to display a permit may result in disciplinary action.



Traffic & Parking Reminder

Please be advised that parking is limited and morning traffic in the area can be unpredictable due to multiple traffic lights, slow turns, and frequent train crossings. We strongly encourage families to plan ahead and leave early to ensure timely arrival.

Parking Policy Violations – Consequences & Notifications

- 1st Offense: Warning and possible detention
- 2nd Offense: Lunch detention
- 3rd Offense: Lunch detention + 1 service hour
- 4th Offense: Two lunch detentions + 2 service hours; possible temporary suspension of on-campus driving privileges

Severe Violations:

- Serious or repeated infractions may result in immediate revocation of on-campus driving privileges.
- Parking violations will be communicated via our behavior notification system. Students may be called from class to move their vehicle and will receive follow-up via email with details of the violation and any resulting consequences.
