## **Uphold School Standards**

Adhere to the dress code, classroom rules, & campus expectations.  
Avoid disruptive, dishonest, or unsafe behaviors.

## **Act with Integrity**

Complete academic work with honesty & personal responsibility.  
Avoid all forms of cheating and plagiarism.

## **Honor School Property and Resources**

Use technology, materials, & school facilities responsibly.  
Refrain from damaging, defacing, or misusing any property.

## **Engage Responsibly in Digital & Social Media**

Avoid inappropriate posts, messages, or digital conduct.  
Never record, post, or share images or content without permission.

Report any unsafe or concerning behavior to a trusted adult.
