We are a Phone Free Campus

Students are not permitted to use mobile phones during school hours including: class time, prep periods, lunch breaks, and passing periods.

What do I do with my phone?

Turn off device
Store device in locker or car
No phones in backpacks
No phones in pockets

Consequences for Cell Phone Policy Violations

- 1st Offense: Phone is confiscated and held in the Dean's office until the end of the day. A warning is issued.
- 2nd Offense: The phone is confiscated and returned at the end of the day. The student receives a lunch detention.
- 3rd Offense: The phone is confiscated and returned at the end of the day. The student receives one lunch detention and one service hour.
- 4th Offense: The phone is confiscated and returned at the end of the day. The student receives two lunch detentions and two service hours.
- Subsequent Offenses: Continued violations will result in escalating disciplinary action, up to and including suspension.

Teachers or staff may confiscate a phone at any time if it is being used in violation of school policy. The administration reserves the right to escalate consequences at their discretion. Exceptions: Students with documented medical needs must provide a healthcare note. All special phone use must be approved in advance by the administration.
