Be on time, Every Time!

Arriving promptly to school and class shows respect and responsibility. Use the SchoolPass app to report absences and tardies early. Missing class adds up—8 unexcused or 15 total absences = loss of credit. Plan ahead for traffic and parking delays. Frequent tardies result in escalating consequences.

Dress for success!

Monday–Thursday, students must wear a collared CVCS logo shirt with khaki (light tan) or navy blue (dark blue) uniform-style pants, shorts, or the approved CVCS skort from Tommy Hilfiger. Brown or black pants are not allowed. Pants must have a traditional fit—no cargo, oversized, or tight styles—and closed-toe shoes are required. On Fridays, students may wear CVCS spirit wear or athletic wear with full-length blue jeans that are free from rips or embellishments. Black denim, shorts, and joggers are not permitted.
