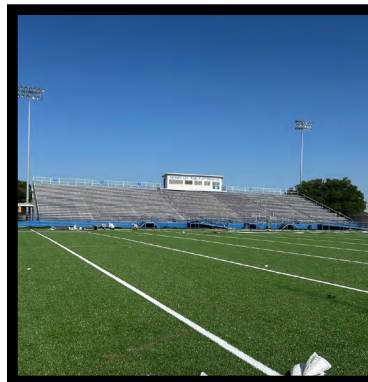
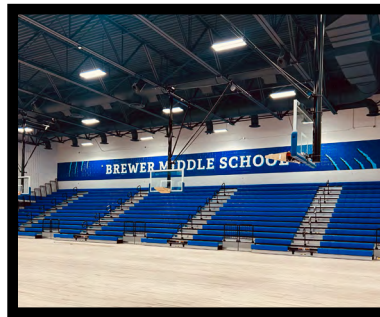
## WELCOME BACK BEARS!

## BUS RIDER REGISTRATION DEADLINE

WSISD provides bus transportation to students who live two or more miles from their home campus. Deadline to complete the Bus Rider Registration Form is Aug. 10. If the [Bus Rider Registration Form](#) is submitted after Aug. 10, the student will not be eligible to ride the bus until Sept. 3. This will enable our drivers to prepare for the upcoming school year. After completing the Bus Rider Registration Form, the Transportation Department will contact you by phone or email to confirm bus stop and pick-up times within 3 to 5 days. Students will be required to ride the bus they're assigned.

Families of bus riders can receive real-time updates and know when the bus is approaching and when your child arrives safely by downloading the SafeStop app.



**NEW TEXAS LAW HB1481: CELL PHONE POLICY**

A new Texas law (HB1481) requires school districts to limit student use of personal communication devices during the school day beginning Aug. 13, 2025.

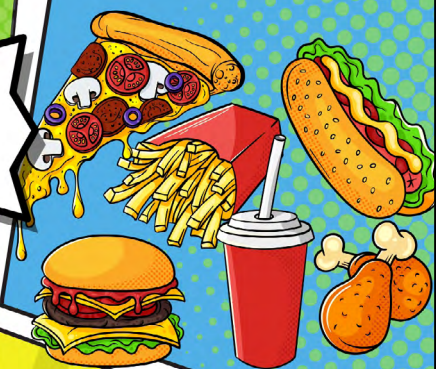


## COMPLETE FREE AND REDUCED MEAL APPLICATION STARTING AUG. 1 TO QUALIFY FOR FREE OR REDUCED MEALS

To be eligible for free or reduced breakfast and lunch, families **MUST** complete an application starting Aug. 1. Applications from last year will be valid through the end of September. All students who are approved for reduced meals will receive free breakfast and lunch for the 2025-2026 school year.

Families must apply through their [Schoolcafe](#) account. Create an account or request a paper application from the school's front office or Child Nutrition Office, 817.367.1310. Individuals who do not apply will start the 2025-26 school year as a paid student. Families who received a notification letter that the student is directly certified for free or reduced meals should not complete an application. Contact the Child Nutrition Office if any children in the household attending school are not listed in the letter.
