#### CONSEQUENCES FOR UNAPPROVED DEVICE USE

1<sup>st</sup> offense: Warning, device put away in backpack in cubby, and parent contacted.

2<sup>nd</sup> offense: Device placed in main office until end of day; and parent contacted.

3<sup>rd</sup> offense: Device held in main office until picked up by a parent.
