#### DEFINITION OF DEVICES

#### BUILDING PLAN FOR STORAGE OF DEVICES

Devices must be kept in student lockers or handed over to a staff member for safe keeping. If needed, students can turn their device into the front office.

#### HOW PARENTS CAN GET IN TOUCH WITH THEIR CHILD

If you need to contact your child during the school day, please call the main office at 585-298-9649. You can also email your student's counselor in order to set up a time to connect with your child.

#### CONSEQUENCES FOR UNAPPROVED DEVICE USE

Students will first be given a warning and told to put their device away and there will be a phone call home. A second offense will result in the device being taken and returned at the end of the day and a support plan being implemented. A third offense will result in the device being taken and held until a parent can pick it up.
