DEFINITION OF DEVICES

Bell-to-Bell restricts the use of all personal internet-enabled devices including: **cellphones, smart watches, tablets, personal laptops** and **any device capable of accessing the internet independently.**

BUILDING PLAN FOR STORAGE OF DEVICES

Students devices are stored in individual cloth pouches, placed in a bin according to district and locked in the office closet.

HOW PARENTS CAN GET IN TOUCH WITH THEIR CHILD

if you need to contact your child during the school day, you can call the main office at 345-589-2400. You can also email your student's counselor in order to set up a time to connect with your child.

CONSEQUENCES FOR UNAPPROVED DEVICE USE

Students who use personal internet-enabled devices during school hours will first be issued a warning and asked to put the device in their locker. A parent will be contacted. Continued unapproved use will result in an individual plan that will include turning their device into an administrator for the full school day and potential parent meeting at school to pick up the device.
