- Spring update - District - Armed Staff Program

### 3. 89th Legislature Updates

#### SB260

- School Safety Allotment \$20 per student in ADA, and \$33,540 per campus

#### SB57

- Ensuring the safety of individuals with disabilities or impairments during drills, disasters

#### HB33 (Uvalde Strong Act)

- To improve active shooter response in primary and secondary schools

#### HB121

- EOPs must contain provisions for ensuring the safety of students, staff, and spectators at extracurricular activities
- TEA shall monitor the response and use of emergency procedures

### 4. EOP Updates

#### a. 25/26 Cycle

- Basic plan and active threat for school annex are due this year.
- The submission window opens Sept 3 and closes Oct 2.
- Lemish will be attending an EOP workshop at the Region Service Center on Aug 7th

### 5. District Vulnerability Assessment: Final Report

- The DVA was conducted in late March
- AISD performed exceptionally well during the process with only 3 minor findings and one suggestion
- May best practices were observed and noted during the walkthroughs.

## 6. Reunification Update
