



General Ray Davis Middle School Dress Code



SHIRTS/TOPS

**Student Choice
with the exceptions below:**

- No undergarments may be visible at any time.
- No halter tops, spaghetti straps, tank tops, low-cut, see-through blouses/shirts,
- No crop tops
- No rubber bands to tie shirts
- No part of the midriff or exposed belly area may be visible
- No rips, tears, holes, shreds, cuts and/or frays that expose skin are permitted in tops and/or jackets.
- Skin may not show at any time.
- No sheer or see-through garments

BOTTOMS

**Student Choice
with the exceptions below:**

- No rips, tears, holes, shreds, cuts and/or frays that expose skin.
- No undergarments may be visible at any time.
- Shorts, skirts, or dresses hem length must be fingertip length at minimum. Any slits must be fingertip length (top of slit).
- No leggings, biker shorts or jeggings unless worn with a dress/skirt/ shirt that comes to the fingertip.
- Pants and skirts must sit at the natural waist.
- Onesies, unitard, body suits are not permitted.
- Pants and other garments should not be form fitting/immodest.
- No sleepwear shall be worn *(unless permitted for special events)*

SHOES/FOOTWEAR

**Student Choice
with the exceptions below:**

- Students are NOT permitted to wear flip flops, slides, or bedroom slippers.
- Crocs are permitted, but straps MUST be always worn on the heel.
- Shoes where the foot is only partially covered may not protect from a safety hazard.

ACCESSORIES

**Student Choice
with the exceptions below:**

- No visors, hats, bandanas, scarves, headwraps, beanies, skull caps, bonnets, or do-rags are allowed.
- Hoods are not allowed to be worn while in the building.
- No sunglasses worn inside the building
- No chains, bandanas, etc. hanging from pants
- bookbags, jackets, purses, etc.
- Blankets are not permitted in school

In addition:

- **Clothing should be free of threatening, demeaning, provocative, illegal or disruptive messages/images.**
- **Clothing must be free from any inappropriate logos, slogans, or phrases.**
- **Clothing should be free of advertisements for drugs, drug paraphernalia, alcohol, tobacco/vape products.**
- **Clothing should not promote the use of controlled substances.**

Any clothing, jewelry, accessories, piercings, etc. determined by the principal or principal's designee to be of an extreme, distracting, or disruptive nature is prohibited.

Any violations of the dress code will be subjected to and addressed in accordance with the RCPS Code of Conduct.
