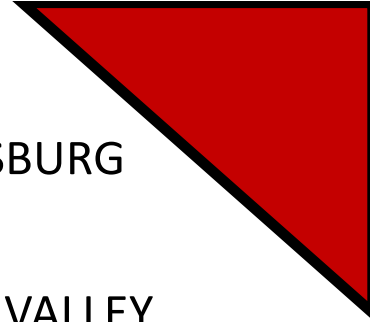

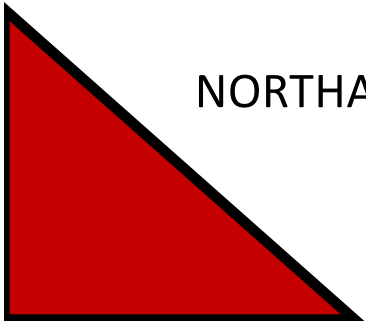

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## EASTON AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT-ATHLETE COMMITMENT

- We often must make cuts to rosters (due to size, uniforms, etc.)
- Therefore, athletes are not permitted to leave an EASD team early for travel teams, tournament teams, family vacations, etc. until EASD season is fully completed (includes playoff games, equipment collection dates, etc.)
- Same above applies to attending EASD Physical Exam dates, ImPACT Testing dates, etc.

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## EASTON AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT-ATHLETE BEHAVIOR

- **In/Out of School Suspension of Athletes**
  - A.D. tries to meet with athletes if suspension occurs/continues
  - Suspension from school = Suspension from activities
- **(H.S.) Lower Parking Lot concerns**
  - NO athletes permitted to park
  - Discuss at parent/player meeting
  - Buses not departing on time due to parent traffic

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## RESPONSIBLE SOCIAL MEDIA USE

- Use Social Media as a tool to promote yourself for future college athletics, workforce, armed forces, etc.
- Do not use Social Media to take away from the great student-athlete you are or can be
- NCAA Athletics opportunities **MAY NOT** be available to you if your Social Media does not portray you in a positive manner

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# RESPONSIBLE SOCIAL MEDIA USE

## Student-Athlete Social Media Agreement

Social media can be a useful tool to communicate with teammates, fans, friends, coaches and more. Social media can also be dangerous if you are not careful. Every picture, link, quote, tweet, status, or post that you or your friends put online is forever part of your digital footprint. You never know when that will come back to hurt or help your reputation during the recruiting process, a new job, or other important areas of your life.

Recognizing the above:

- \_\_\_\_\_ I take responsibility for my online profile, including my posts and any photos, videos or other recordings posted by others in which I appear.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I will not degrade my opponents before, during, or after games.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I will post only positive things about my teammates, coaches, opponents and officials.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I will use social media to purposefully promote abilities, team, community, and social values.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I will consider "Is this the me I want you to see?" before I post anything online.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I will ignore any negative comments about me and will not retaliate.
- \_\_\_\_\_ If I see a teammate post something potentially negative online, I will have a conversation with that teammate. If I do not feel comfortable doing so, I will talk to the team captain, or a coach.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I am aware that I represent my sport(s), school, team, family and community at all times, and will do so in a positive manner.

Headline: Dear Mom and Dad: Cool it

If you are the mother or father of a high school athlete here in Pennsylvania, this message is primarily for you.

When you attend an athletic event that involves your son or daughter, cheer to your heart's content, enjoy the camaraderie that high school sports offer and have fun. But when it comes to verbally criticizing game officials or coaches, cool it.

Make no mistake about it. Your passion is admired, and your support of the hometown team is needed. But so is your self-control. Yelling, screaming and berating the officials humiliates your child, annoys those sitting around you, embarrasses your child's school and is the primary reason Pennsylvania has an alarming shortage of high school officials.

It's true. According to a recent survey by the National Association of Sports Officials, more than 75 percent of all high school officials say "adult behavior" is the primary reason they quit. And 80 percent of all young officials hang up their stripes after just two years of whistle blowing. Why? They don't need your abuse.

Plus, there's a ripple effect. There are more officials over 60 than under 30 in many areas. And as older, experienced officials retire, there aren't enough younger ones to replace them. If there are no officials, there are no games. The shortage of licensed high school officials is severe enough in some areas that athletic events are being postponed or cancelled—especially at the freshman and junior varsity levels.

Research confirms that participation in high school sports and activities instills a sense of pride in school and community, teaches lifelong lessons like the value of teamwork and self-discipline and facilitates the physical and emotional development of those who participate. So, if the games go away because there aren't enough men and women to officiate them, the loss will be infinitely greater than just an "L" on the scoreboard. It will be putting a dent in your community's future.

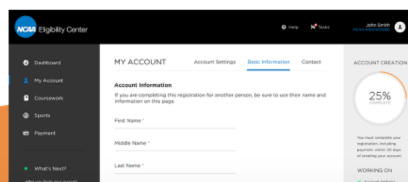

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# EASTON AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT NCAA ELIGIBILITY

## SAT / ACT and the Eligibility Center

- The SAT score used for NCAA purposes includes only the critical reading and math sections. **The writing section of the SAT is not used.**
- The ACT score used for NCAA purposes is a **sum** of the four sections on the ACT: English, Math, Reading and Science
- All SAT and ACT scores must be reported directly to the NCAA Initial Eligibility Clearinghouse by the testing agency. The code for the Eligibility Clearinghouse is 9999 and must be entered as a score recipient when you register for the SAT or ACT. The Guidance Office CAN NOT send your scores.**

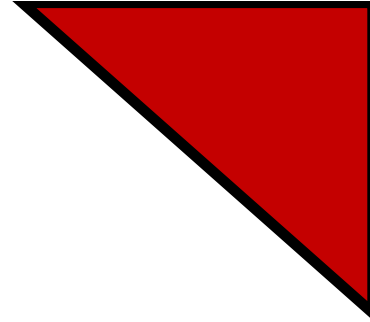
IN ACCORDANCE WITH PIAA POLICY ON NIL:

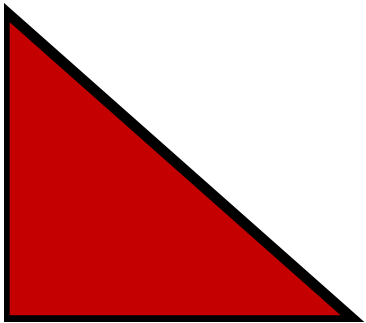

Physical exam process

- MUST be present
- Paperwork must be reviewed by our school nurses, doctor, and trainers

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# EASTON AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT ATHLETICS EQUIPMENT

## Equipment Issuance

- ALL equipment is numbered/lettered
  - Issued through and collected by Equipment Managers for tracking purposes
  - DO NOT RETURN IT TO GRADE LEVEL OFFICES
- Failure to return = ineligibility for next athletic season, legal action by local magistrate
- Common problems
  - Exchanging equipment with others on team, numbers will not match the issued equipment = someone pays for equipment



# EASTON AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT MISC. INFORMATION

## Lines of Communication

- **“Parent/Coach Communication Plan”** (EASD website)

Jewelry and Valuables - leave at home

## Transportation

- **Must ride school district transportation unless an “emergency” requires alternate transportation.**
- An “Alternate Transportation” form must be completed at least one day prior to event – NEED AD approval
- Good Behavior Is Expected To/From Games/Practices

## Picture Day

- Schedule is set
- Forms and money must be given to photographer at time of pictures or can be ordered online (Christmas City Studios)

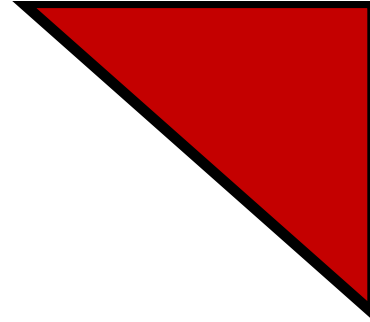

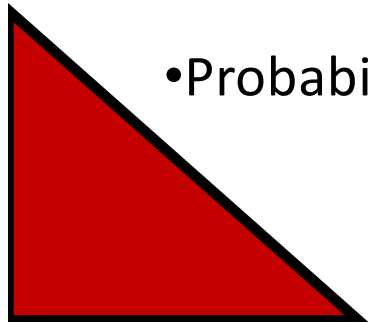
