Painting of Parking Spaces
2025

This year, student drivers will have the opportunity to paint/personalize a parking space on campus. The painted parking spaces are \$50, and this fee will include a parking pass. A \$25 security deposit is also required. This \$25 fee will be returned to you if, at the end of the year, you return the parking spot to its original state, which requires you to cover your personalized design with black paint; otherwise, the \$25 covers the school expense to paint the space black. The parking spots are on a first-come, first-served basis and will be offered to seniors first, then juniors, etc. The parking spots will go on sale on **August 5, 2025**, in the office. Your parking spot is reserved for you daily during the hours of 7:30-2:30. Please know that after the winter months, your space may show signs of our snow plow clearing the parking lot. The proceeds of this fundraiser will help fund the Spartan Standard PBIS Rewards.

The painting party will be on Wednesday and Thursday evening **ONLY**. No other time will be scheduled for painting. Rain dates will be August 18 & 19.

A Parking Design Request form (see below) must be submitted to the office no later than August 12, 2025, for approval.

Guideline for your Design Sketch:

Think of your space as a t-shirt you would wear to school. Your parking spot must meet dress code approval. Keep it classy! Any design associated with gangs, advertising drugs, alcohol, violence, obscene slogans, handicap symbols, or symbols that may cause confusion or promote illegal activities will not be permitted or approved. You may include your name, jersey number, the instrument you play, your hobby, famous quotes or slogans, and anything unique to you that meets administrative approval. Make it fun!

Paint Requirements:

WATER-BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint is the only type of paint that may be used. Students will also need to leave an approximately four-inch unpainted border between the white parking space lines and the paint in their parking spot. Please use blue painter's tape to ensure this border is accomplished. You may purchase WATER-BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint at Sherwin-Williams on Canton Road. Consider sharing with others who are also painting a spot. All paint will be the responsibility of the student.

UNAPPROVED PAINTS:

- No oil-based paints
- No reflective paint
- No spray paint
- No fluorescent paint
- No paint sprayers
- No clear coat



What to Bring to the Painting Party:

Be sure to bring your approved design/sketches with you on paint day. Also, you will be responsible for all paintbrushes, rollers, paint pans, and painting tape. A broom to sweep off your spot before painting will save you lots of time. You will want to bring lawn chairs for your entire family, a canopy or market umbrella, sunscreen, drinks, stencils, rags for cleaning and sacks or bags to dispose of trash, a drop cloth, and paint clothes. This will be a really fun activity for the entire family, and has become a great memorable tradition for our student drivers!
