



Spectator Code of Conduct

Unless authorized by school officials, spectators are not allowed on the playing area at any time (before, during, or after competitions). Student sections must sit or stand in the bleachers. Standing on the floor at indoor events is not permitted.

“Rushing the Field/Court” is not allowed at any time.

BE POSITIVE. Cheer only for your team. Do not direct negative cheers or taunts toward the opponent. Negative or profane language is strictly prohibited.

Respect the referees and game officials.

No coaching from the sidelines by parents or spectators.

At all indoor events artificial noise makers are not allowed.

At outdoor events, noise makers may be allowed subject to the discretion of the school administration. Items that are used in the contest or which would present a disruption such as whistles, drums, air horns etc. are not allowed.

No alcohol or tobacco is allowed at youth or school activities.

CLEAN UP. Help keep the facilities clean. Please use receptacles.

Be gracious when you win, be graceful when you lose.

Appropriate attire (including shirts) must be worn at all times.

Signs may be allowed subject to the discretion of school officials.

School officials retain the right to refuse admittance or remove a person(s) from an event due to inappropriate behavior. Spectators who are removed will not be able to attend the next event as determined by school officials and must complete the NFHS Sportsmanship Course before being reinstated.
