Role 2: Call 911 using the script below. Retrieve AED if needed. Retrieve Emergency Card. Assist in CPR.

Role 3: Direct EMS to the Athletic Training Room using the front entrance closest to the stadium off of Fannett Road.

Script for EMS call: "My name is [name] at Beaumont United High School at 3443 Fannett Rd. I have an injured student athlete in the field house athletic training room. Enter through the front school gate off of Fannett Road. Go straight between the school and parking lot. The Field House is the building next to the football stadium. There will be someone waiting in the parking lot wearing [describe clothes]." Be prepared with the phone number you are calling from, athlete(s) name, age, injury or illness and care already provided.

Go straight between the school and parking lot. Turn left on the service road between the Main Gym and Jackson Center. There will be someone waiting in the parking lot wearing [describe clothes]." Be prepared with the phone number you are calling from, athlete(s) name, age, injury or illness and care already provided.

Enter through the back gate of the school on Sarah Street. The baseball field is on the right side of the concussion stand. There will be someone waiting in the parking lot wearing [describe clothes]." Be prepared with the phone number you are calling from, athlete(s) name, age, injury or illness and care already provided.

Enter through the front school gate on Fannett Road. Go straight between the field house and Jackson Center on the service road. The soccer practice field is on the left side of the service road. There will be someone waiting in the parking lot wearing [describe clothes]." Be prepared with the phone number you are calling from, athlete(s) name, age, injury or illness and care already provided.
