Sault Ste. Marie Area Public Schools is proud to announce the successful passage of the 2025 Bond Proposal, following the election on August 5, 2025. The approved no-mil increase bond, totaling 20.5 million, will allow the district to move forward on needed facility improvements in key areas.

“We are deeply grateful to the voters of our district for standing behind the students and staff of Sault Ste. Marie Area Public Schools,” said Superintendent Kronemeyer. “This bond reflects the power of community collaboration and represents a bold investment in our children’s future, one that will drive meaningful improvements for decades to come.”

The 2025 Bond will support the development of modern, flexible learning spaces and address long-standing facility needs while maintaining the current tax rate for residents. Planned enhancements include replacing aging infrastructure, reimagining shared spaces to support 21st-century learning, improving safety throughout the buildings, and upgrading areas that support student services and play areas.

The passage of this bond is a powerful affirmation that our community values strong public education and is committed to nurturing the environments where our students learn, grow, and thrive.
