

# FERPA Privacy Act

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records. However, schools may disclose, without consent, "directory" information such as a student's name, address, telephone number, date and place of birth, honors and awards, and dates of attendance.

If you would prefer that "directory" information about your child not be released by the district, please return this form to the main office no later than September 6th.

- **This form only needs to be returned if you DO NOT want this information to be shared.**
- **Failure to return this form will indicate your consent for this information to be shared.**
