



# Student Chromebook Acceptable Use Policy and Agreements

To support student learning, the district provides Chromebooks. Students and parents/guardians must agree to the following terms for proper use and care:

- 1. General Use:** Chromebooks are for academic purposes only. Students must bring them to school fully charged. Personal use is not allowed during school hours. Parents should monitor Chromebook use at home at all times (The district is not responsible for student's exposure to internet browsing during home use). **Central Islip One-to-One Technology Guide:** <https://www.centralislip.k12.ny.us/1-1>
- 2. Care & Maintenance:** Handle Chromebooks with care. Avoid drops, heavy objects, or liquids. Keep Chromebooks in a safe place, like a backpack or locker. Use only approved cleaners for screens and keyboards.
- 3. Security, Privacy & Safety:** Chromebooks are to be used by the student to which it is assigned. Sharing of Chromebooks between students is prohibited. Keep passwords secure; do not share them. The district can monitor Chromebook usage. There's no expectation of privacy. Never share personal information online. - 4. Damage, Loss, and Theft:** Report any damage immediately. Families may be responsible for repair costs if due to negligence. Report lost or stolen Chromebooks to the school right away. Parents may be liable for replacement costs. **Review all associated fees at** <https://www.centralislip.k12.ny.us/fees>.
- 5. Internet and Software:** The district blocks inappropriate websites on the school network. Parents should monitor use at home. Only district-approved apps and software are allowed. **Review district approved programs & websites at:** <https://www.centralislip.k12.ny.us/programs>.
- 6. Chargers:** The district will provide ONE charger for at home charging. Parents/guardians are responsible for any replacement charger needs. The district does not supply replacement chargers.
- 7. Consequences for Misuse:** Follow the district's policies (<https://www.centralislip.k12.ny.us/aup>). Violations may result in disciplinary action, including the loss of Chromebook privileges. Students remain responsible for completing all digital assignments, schoolwork, projects, virtual sessions, Google Classroom tasks, etc., even if Chromebook Privileges are revoked for any reason.
- 8. Support:** Parent/Student will bring the Student Device to the building's designated support office for any support, maintenance, breakages, battery failures, screen damage or if the Chromebook fails to operate as intended for support.
