Park City School Community,

We want to provide you with an important update regarding the ongoing construction at the future site of our Treasure Mountain Sports Complex and reaffirm that the safety of our students, staff, and community is our top priority.

Construction crews have begun initial work on the site, which has been securely fenced off with access limited to authorized personnel only. As part of this early phase, crews are removing surface organics and preparing to place imported clean fill material.

It's important to note that no contaminated soils have been exposed. The protective cap remains in place and has not been penetrated. More specifically, the current construction plan is designed to avoid disturbing the subsurface area, where contaminated soil begins at a minimum depth of six (6) inches and may vary. The District has a full-time environmental consultant on site who is actively monitoring the air quality, soils disturbance, and compliance with the developed work practices and soils management plan. The environmental consultant reports to the Utah Department of Environmental Quality who oversees regulatory activity to ensure adherence to the conditions required by the Environmental Protection Agency under the Environmental Covenant.

To further protect our school community:

- A water truck will be on-site daily to suppress dust.
- Clean soil and rock will be added to improve drainage for the future turf fields.
- Nearby schools and the district office are positively pressurized, preventing outside air from entering the buildings.
- Air filters are being replaced weekly as an added layer of protection.

We're taking every step to ensure the health and safety of all individuals in and around the construction area while preparing this facility for future student use. We appreciate your continued support and will keep you updated as work progresses.
