

All Nueva applicants for grades PreK–8 are required to take a Wechsler IQ assessment. **The assessment report must be submitted to Nueva directly from the administering psychologist.**

Nueva accepts the results of the WPPSI-IV or WISC-V assessments. Applicants must be 3 years 10 months or older to take the WPPSI-IV. Applicants who are 6 years of age and older must take the WISC-V.

Wechsler assessment results for grades PreK–8 are due no later than **January 8, 2026**, but we encourage all families to submit results by **November 3, 2025** if possible.

Information about our **November 3, 2025** Guarantee Deadline for kindergarten and grades 5–8 applicants can be found on our website and on Ravenna.

All completed Nueva application materials are due no later than **January 8, 2026**.

NOTE: Wechsler assessment results for PreK Round II applicants (see our website for more information) are due no later than **March 24, 2026**. All other completed application materials are due no later than **January 8, 2026**.

Any licensed psychologist trained in administering the Wechsler to children may administer the assessment. Nueva's Psychologist Resource List is a helpful place to start your search for a psychologist in the Bay Area; this can be found in Ravenna and on our website.

Prior exposure to assessment materials and/or use of practice questions invalidates results. The Wechsler is designed to capture current cognitive abilities. Your child should not prepare for this assessment. Wechsler assessment results determined to be in range for Nueva's purposes are admissible for two consecutive admissions seasons.

Applicants who have taken a Wechsler assessment and wish to be reassessed must wait a full 12 months from the date it was taken before sitting for the assessment again.

The administering psychologist needs your signed permission to release the results to Nueva. Please provide the administering psychologist with the Guidelines for Psychologists Submitting Assessment Results document. Once the assessment is completed, delegate the Wechsler Submission Form through Ravenna.

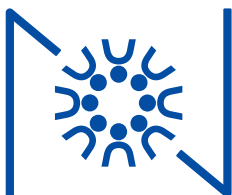
After the psychologist has submitted the results and required documents to Ravenna, the Admissions Office will follow up with you regarding whether your child is eligible to continue in the application process.

The Wechsler assessment serves as an initial screening step in the application process to determine whether Nueva is a potential match for your child.

Students with a Full Scale Wechsler IQ Score around 130 and above are more likely to be successful in Nueva's program. However, the Admissions Office encourages families to submit their child's results, regardless of the score, as this will allow the Admissions Office to determine whether your child is eligible to continue in the process.

Families are welcome to informally submit IQ assessment results before formally applying to Nueva. This allows a family to find out whether their child's scores fall within the range considered eligible to continue in the application process. 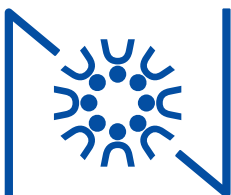
