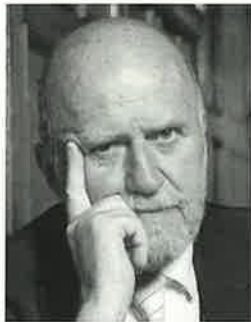

ASL teachers honored

The Alumni Association Board of Directors honored former ASL teachers Helen Blum, Don Jesse, James McGovern, Paul Morton and Margot Sreberny as inaugural recipients of the Stephen Eckard

Award for Inspiring and Dedicated Service to Education. The five were recognized at a reception at Lincoln's Inn during reunion weekend.

The Alumni Association sought nominations from the worldwide ASL family during the winter term. A committee representing two alumni from each decade and three members of the ASL Alumni Board of Directors reviewed these nominations and selected the five recipients. It is projected

that in future years two recipients will be named annually.

To be eligible, nominees must have worked at ASL for five or more consecutive years and be retired or deceased; or worked five or more consecutive years and been off the ASL payroll for at least five years. They may have served as teachers, administrators or School staff. The award may be made posthumously.
