**Outstanding Contributor** 

Dick served as the 7th Athletic Director at Chaska High School and made a lasting impact across athletics, arts, and student life. A gifted artist, he created the iconic Chaska Hawk logo, a powerful symbol of school pride and identity. As the founding Athletic Director of the school's signature fundraiser—originally the Gala and BBQ Bash, now known as the Chaska Bash—Dick helped build a tradition of community support for Chaska athletics. He also established the school's National Letter of Intent (NLI) signing ceremony, honoring student-athletes continuing their sports at the collegiate level.

Beyond administration, Dick coached football (1993–2002), served as strength coordinator (1993–1997), and coached track & field (1998–2002). He also contributed to student life as yearbook advisor (1995–2002), helping students document school history.

Dick's professional affiliations include active membership in the Minnesota Interscholastic Activities Administrators Association (MNIAAA) and the Minnesota Association of Secondary School Principals (MASSP), where he contributed to statewide conversations on educational leadership and student development.
