WHEN ARE THE SCHOOL BREAKS?

Break schedules, parent teacher conferences and other important dates are found on our <u>district calendars</u>. Keep an eye out in your mailboxes as district calendars will be mailed to families in the next few weeks.

HOW CAN I PAY MY CHILD'S SCHOOL FEES AND ADD FUNDS TO MY CHILD'S CAFETERIA ACCOUNT?

Parents/guardians need to create an account with PaySchools Central (if one hasn't already been created) in order to submit online payments. The site can be accessed via an online portal or via a convenient mobile app. Go to our PaySchools Central webpage to pay school fees and add funds to your child's lunch account.

You can also **apply for free/reduced meals in PaySchools Central**. If you qualify for free/reduced meals, you may be eligible to have your child's school fees waived, but you must say YES in the "Sharing Information with Other Programs" form found in <u>FinalForms</u>. Read the <u>FAQ about Free/Reduced Price School Meals here</u>.

A Note for Crim Elementary Families: Crim Elementary participates in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) under the National School Lunch Program (NSLP). Under this option, *all children in the school receive a breakfast/lunch at no charge*.

However, to determine eligibility for various additional state and federal program benefits that your child's school may qualify for, such as the **school fees waiver**, please complete, sign and return the <u>HOUSEHOLD</u> INFORMATION SURVEY to the Crim office if your income falls within or below the guidelines listed in the chart. You must also say YES in the "Sharing Information with Other Programs" form found in <u>FinalForms</u> to have your child's school fees waived.

WHERE CAN I FIND SCHOOL SUPPLY LISTS?

High School students will get their supply lists during high school registration days August 11-14. School supply lists for PK- 8 are listed on each school web page. (See links on first page of this document).

WHERE CAN I FIND MY CHILD'S BUS INFORMATION?

Sign up for the My Ride K-12 Transportation App to see bus stop location, route, and pick up and drop times. This information is updated for the 2025-26 school year.

HOW CAN I GET MY CHILD ENROLLED?

If you are new to the district or have a kindergartener (must be 5 yrs old by 8/1/25) find <u>enrollment information</u> here.

WHO DO I CONTACT WITH QUESTIONS?

Contact the main office of your child's school. Note: Breakfast and lunch menus will be posted soon.
