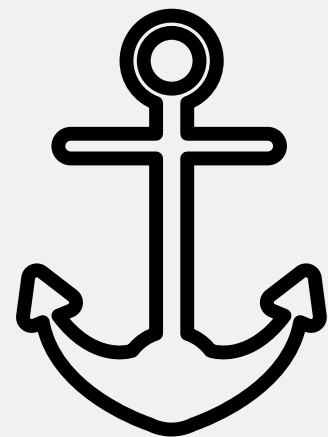


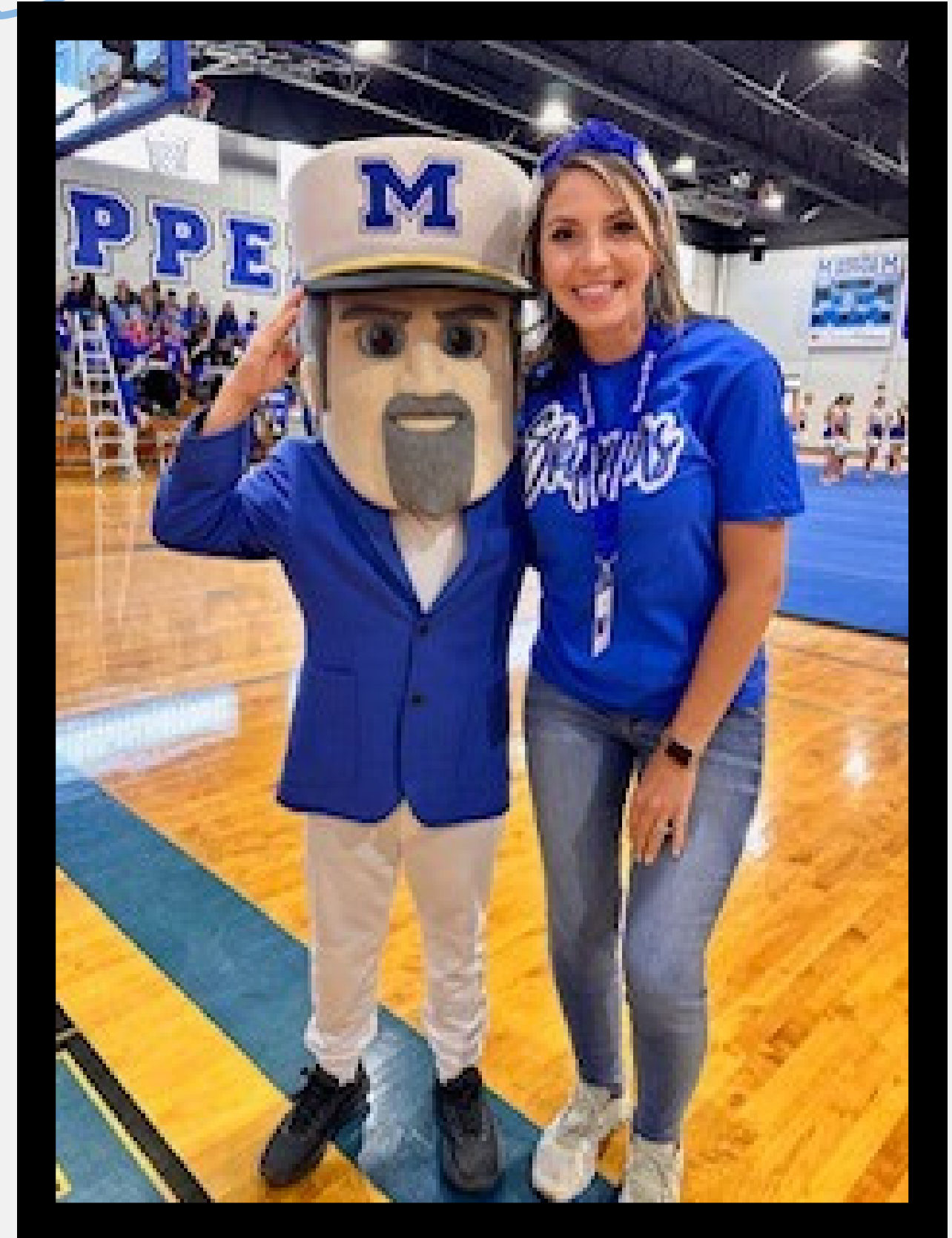

Class of 2029 color - green

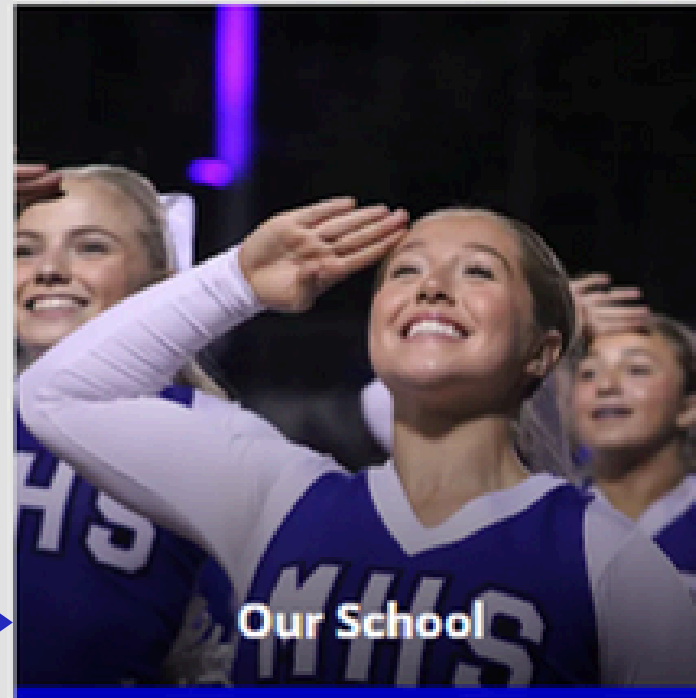
Freshman will be given a free green lanyard in homeroom.

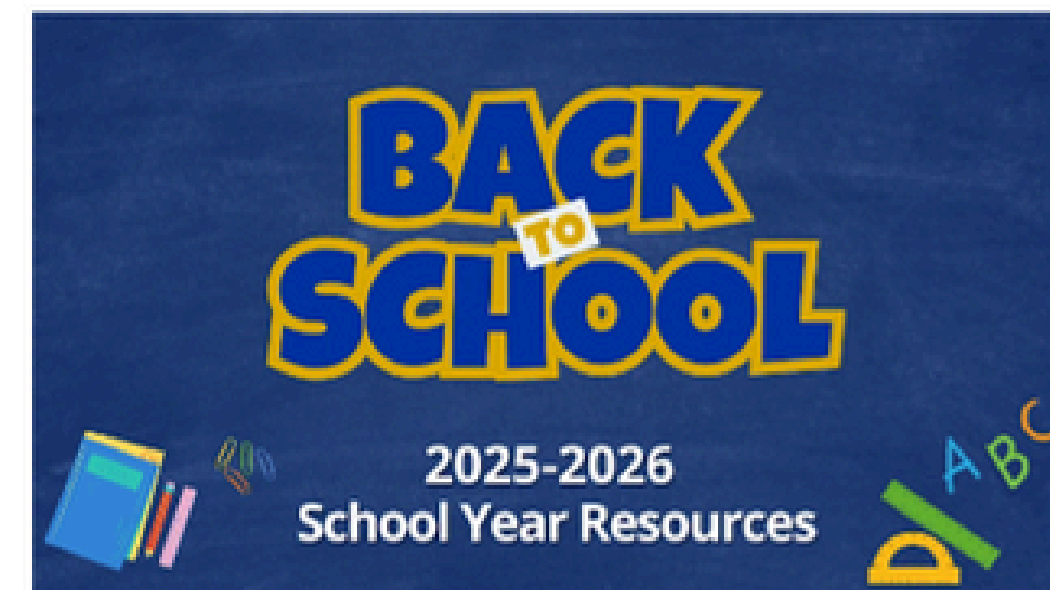


Follow the MHS Calendar on Your Phone:
