Galena Park ISD Board of Trustees Named 2025 Texas Honor Board

Houston, TX — August 6, 2025 — Galena Park Independent School District (GPISD) proudly announces that its Board of Trustees has been named a 2025 Texas Honor School Board by the Texas Association of School Administrators (TASA). This prestigious recognition honors outstanding school boards across Texas for their dedication and positive impact on public school students.

After a comprehensive and detailed application process at the regional level, GPISD's Board of Trustees was named the 2024 Region 4 Board of the Year and selected as Region 4's nominee for the statewide Texas Honor School Boards. GPISD is now a top-five finalist for TASA's Outstanding School Board Award, with the winner to be announced in September at the TASA/TASB Convention in Houston.

Each year, TASA selects a small number of school boards based on their commitment to educational performance, improvement projects, adherence to a code of ethics, and fostering collaborative, supportive relationships among board members. This year, GPISD is proud to be one of only five school boards statewide to receive the Honor Board distinction.

The School Board Awards Committee praised the GPISD Board of Trustees for being a highly functioning, collaborative, and student-focused board. The committee highlighted the board's support for educational improvement, academic excellence across a diverse student population, emphasis on professional development, and commitment to student mental health and emotional support. The board's active engagement with the community was also noted, especially its leadership in the recent passage of the 2024 bond with overwhelming voter support.

Superintendent John Moore, who nominated the board, stated, "Under the board's committed leadership, our Galena Park ISD students have performed exceptionally well in every index, but the achievements of our students go far beyond the walls of the classrooms. Galena Park ISD students have accomplished amazing things under this board's leadership and encouragement, whether in academics, athletics, fine arts, or career and technical education. Indeed, our trustees are the students' greatest cheerleaders, in victory and defeat, and it is not uncommon to see them cheering students on at athletic events, academic meets, and other school programs."
