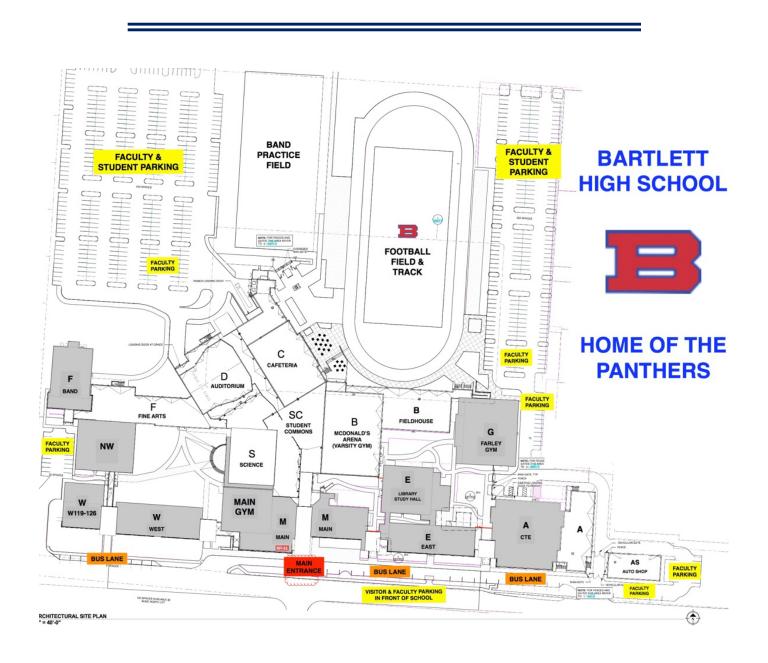


### BARTLETT HIGH SCHOOL 2025-2026 First Day of School Information August 7, 2025

Students will report to Homeroom on Thursday, August the 7<sup>th</sup> and Friday, August the 8<sup>th</sup>. An abbreviated bell schedule will be followed these two days. Homeroom rosters are posted throughout the school, and can also be found at the end of this document.

All students will receive a printed schedule on the first day of school and are expected to follow that schedule. PLEASE NOTE: Schedules released on "B" Ready Day are subject to change (i.e. teachers or class periods) due to balancing of classes and minor schedule changes.

Please follow these procedures to ensure attendance is accurate for your student.

- Parents/Students have 48 hours (2 school days) to turn in an absent note.
- At home, parents and students will follow a link to electronically submit an absence excuse note using a Microsoft Form. PARENTS WILL USE THEIR STUDENT'S MICROSOFT 365 ACCOUNT TO SUBMIT THE ABSENCE: <a href="https://forms.office.com/r/LYW8uwVn3Z">https://forms.office.com/r/LYW8uwVn3Z</a>

At school, students will scan a QR code in first period to electronically submit an absence excuse note.

- Must upload a picture or PDF of the excuse note when submitting this form. Prior to 10 absences, a parent note is sufficient.Parent notes require a handwritten signature of the parent or guardian.
- BHS will not accept form submissions without an attached attendance note.
- Students and Parents should check PowerSchool regularly to ensure all properly submitted attendance notes are processed.
- Check-in and Check-out notes must still be turned in the old-fashioned way to the 1<sup>st</sup> period teacher or the attendance office.



PowerSchool is how students and parents access grades, view attendance, email teachers, etc.

■ PowerSchool does not open for Bartlett Ninth Grade Academy and High School students and parents until after Labor Day each year. You will be provided with the credentials to create an account at that time.

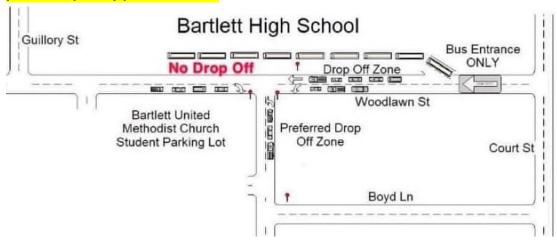

- Regular Parking Pass costs \$60.00
- **SENIORS ONLY** can paint a parking space, and that Parking Pass costs \$100.00
- Parking passes will only be issued to students who have a valid driver's license. Please use the link to purchase your parking pass. Parking passes will need to be picked up from Officer Purcell's office, downstairs Main Building.



All Students at the Main Campus should be dropped off and picked up on Woodlawn Street not in the student lots off of Blackwell Street. The school doors will NOT open until 6:30 AM regardless of weather. Please do not wait in the drop off zone in the morning. This is a true pull up and drop off zone. If you are getting to school early and waiting with your student, please temporarily park elsewhere.

#### Key Items:

- One replacement charger will be covered under the insurance fee. After one replacement is used, there is a \$50 charge for a laptop charger or a \$25 charge for an iPad charger.
- Our insurance fee structure is the same this year. A single student will pay \$25, a family with 2 students will pay \$50, and a family with 3 or more students will pay \$75.
- Laptop cases are STRONGLY encouraged to protect the device against any accidental spills and drops. Several options are available on Amazon. When ordering, please make sure the case is compatible with Apple 13-inch MacBook Air, Model A3113.

In order for Bartlett City Schools to maintain a safe and orderly learning environment, the minimum standards for acceptable clothing during the school day are as follows:

- Tops of shoulders must be covered by a minimum of a 1-inch strap unless otherwise covered by an opaque top garment. Tops must also have sleeves and must completely cover the torso from the arm pits to the waist. The torso is defined as all parts of the body not including the arms, legs, neck, and head.
- Skin and undergarments must be covered with opaque (not able to be seen through) clothing from the underarm to mid-thigh. Mid-thigh is defined as the mid-point between the waist and mid-knee.
- All bottoms must be held at the waist, be appropriately sized, and of a safe length.
- Compression-style garments may be worn so long as an opaque top garment covers the entire torso below the armpits.
- Head apparel (such as hoods, hats, sunglasses, etc.) must not be worn inside the school building, except for religious or medical reasons.
- Footwear is required and must be safe and appropriate for indoor and outdoor physical activity.
- Prohibited items include the following: large, long, and/or heavy chains; chained accessories; and sleepwear, pajamas, and/or blankets.
- Clothing and accessories such as backpacks, patches, jewelry, and notebooks may not display (1) racial or ethnic slurs/symbols; (2) gang affiliations; (3) vulgar, subversive, or sexually suggestive language or images; nor promote inappropriate and/or illegal products such as alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs;

Any student not dressed in accordance with the policy shall be directed to correct the violation or spend the remainder of the day in in-school suspension (ISS). Repeat offenses shall be subject to additional measures which include parent conferences, inschool suspension, and out-of-school suspensions as described in the District-wide discipline policy.



- Students qualify for the Certificate of Compulsory Attendance after their first month at Bartlett High School
- Students needing the Certificate of Compulsory Attendance letter to obtain their permit need to sign up for it Monday Thursday in the Attendance Office. They can pick up their letter on Fridays during their lunch period. The cost is \$1.00.

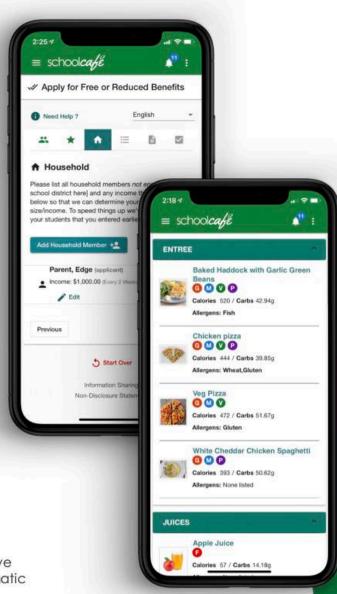
Applying for free and reduced meal benefits has never been easier. Apply, submit, and track your application status from start to finish.

#### **Quick Answers**

How do I add money/make a payment to my child's account? Send money to school with your student, or add money through SchoolCafé. Follow the steps in the Make a Payment section.

When can my student use the online payment I made? Your student's cafeteria account at the school is credited within 24 hours, but may be available as quickly as 2 hours.

Is there a fee/service charge for online payments? Convenience fee amounts vary by school district and may be charged for each online payment transaction. For example, if you make a \$20 payment and the convenience fee is \$1, the total debited from your credit card is \$21. The available funds for your child will be \$20.

Can I receive notification when my student's account balance is low?

Yes! Follow the steps in Set Up a Low Balance Alert section.

Why was my account locked when making a payment? After three failed payment attempts, the payment function is locked. Contact SchoolCafé to remove the lock.

What if I have several students in different schools? Include as many students as needed in your account. The students can attend any school within the same district. Payments for each student are made separately.

Can I transfer money from one child to another? Contact the Child Nutrition Services office at the school district for assistance with a transfer.

What happens to the money in my account at the end of the school year? What if I need to receive a refund?

Your account balance moves with your student(s) from grade to grade and school to school within the district. Contact the Child Nutrition Services office at the school district for assistance with a refund.

\*You will be asked to verify your security answer and contact information when you request help with your username, password, or other information on your Profile page.

- b. Select I'm a Parent and click Next
- c. Enter your school district name and click Next
- d. Enter your name and contact information, and click Next Step
- e. Set up your username and password
- f. Select a Security Question and enter a Security Answer, and click Next Step
- g. Click I'm not a robot and follow the reCAPTCHA prompts (if they appear)
- h. Check I accept the Terms & Conditions and click Create My Account

- a. Click Students → Student Accounts
- b. Click Add a Student
- c. Enter your student's Student ID
- d. Select your student's School
- e. Click Search & Verify Student
- f. Click Add this Student
- \*Your district may ask for different or additional information.

#### 3. Add Payment Source

- a. Click My Account → Payment Sources
- b. Click Add a Card
- c. Enter a short Friendly Card Name to identify the
- d. Enter your Card Number
- e. Enter Card Expiration date
- f. Click Add Card

#### 4. Make a Payment

- a. Click Students → Make a Payment
- b. Enter dollar amount in Payment for each student c. If:
- You see the "Other District Payments" page, enter dollar amount(s) as needed
- · You don't see the "Other District Payments" page, skip to the next step
- d. Click Next >
- e. Select a Payment Source, or enter card information for a one-time payment
- f. Click Submit Payment >

#### Set Automatic Payment

- 1. Click Students → Automatic Payments
- 2. Click Set in a student listing
- 3. Enter dollar amount in Payment Amount
- 4. Enter dollar amount in Balance Threshold to trigger an automatic payment
- 5. Select a Payment Source, or enter information for a new card
- 6. Enter a date in Expire Auto Pay On to stop automatic payments
- 7. Click Save

- 1. Click Students → Student Accounts
- 2. Click ( Low Balance Alert) in a student listing
- 3. Enter dollar amount to trigger the alert in

- 4. Enter the number of days to expire before resending the alerts
- 5. Click Save

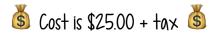

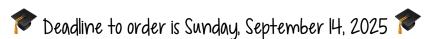
In field where it says FIRST NAME - you will put exactly what you want on the sign.

#### FIRST NAME ONLY IS RECOMMENDED

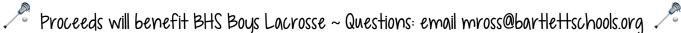
Adding last name and putting in your yard can be a safety concern. \*If more than 10 letters, it will become squished and won't look as nice\*

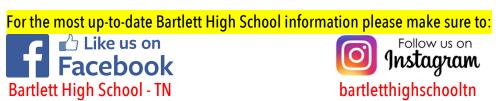
