## ATTENTION PARENTS!



Physicals and vaccinations for current Kindergarten and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students were due by 10/15/2020. Completed Hepatitis B vaccination series for ALL students were due by 11/4/2020. If you have not turned in the required paperwork, your child is now considered NON-COMPLIANT. This means that they will not be allowed to attend any in person learning or extra-curricular activities until the required documentation has been received. If/when we are able to return remote students to in person learning, non-compliant students will NOT be allowed to attend. Current 5<sup>th</sup> grade parents please start scheduling those 6<sup>th</sup> grade physicals NOW! Physicals are due prior to the first day of the 2021-2022 school year and many offices are still seeing a limited number of patients due to their COVID protocols. Two vaccinations are also required for 6<sup>th</sup> grade- Tdap and meningococcal. These vaccines can be given on or after the 12<sup>th</sup> birthday.
