## Attendance

- ❖ Tardies
  - >1st Hour
    - Until 8:00
    - Parents can only excuse 2 per semester
  - >2<sup>nd</sup> − 7<sup>th</sup> Hours: first 10 minutes
  - ➤ As tardies build students are subject to detentions and ISS
- ❖ Absences show UNV until excused by a parent, or changed to UNX through the office.
- ❖ Parents can request work due to absences through Guidance (3+ days) as well as have students check Google Classroom and email teachers
- Extended absence or moving, please contact Guidance Office

## Attendance


- Call attendance within two days (leave a message)
- The autodialer goes out each day on unverified absences.
- Excessive absences may result in truancy through the county courts
  - ➤ 3 UNX in a row, 5 in a semester, 7 in a school year
  - ➤ After 10 days of EAB all absences count UNX and towards truancy
  - ➤ Doesn't count: MED (medical with note from doctor), ACT (school activity)

EAB = Excused Absence
UNX = Unexcused Absence
UNV = Unverified Absence (potential referral)
EXT = Excused Tardy
TDY= Unexcused Tardy
