In preparation for the 2025-2026 school year, please review the following information to ensure that your student is prepared for a successful start of school:


- The first day of school will be on Wednesday, August 13th.
- Free breakfast is available starting at 8:30 am.
- Regular school attendance is required, with students arriving by 9:00 am for their first period class.
- School ends at 12:50 pm every Monday.
- School ends at 2:00 pm every Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.
- Students must follow the enclosed **Dress Code Policy**.

Being present in class is essential for academic progress and completion of graduation course requirements. Students are expected to attend all scheduled school days, arriving by 9:00 am for the start of their first class and being on time for all other scheduled classes during the day.
