- Navigate to the Qmlativ log in page by following the link in ClassLink or by typing the URL: q.skschools.org

- Use the same username/password combination that you used to access Skyward Family Access
  - Parents who are also employees will use their network username/password to login to
- Delete or update any bookmarks/shortcuts you've created to navigate to Family Access in the past

- Once logged in you'll see your student(s) along the top of the page. Select a student to see their specific information
- Click on the tiles on your home screen to view information regarding Attendance, Grading, Transportation, and more
- Use the Home icon to return to your dashboard







Qmlativ uses the same mobile app that users downloaded for the previous version of Skyward


The app needs to be removed and then reinstalled in order to pull the most up-to-date version

If you already have the Skyward Mobile App please delete the app from your phone
 Press and hold the Skyward app icon and then select "Remove App" from the menu that appears



Visit your App Store and search for "Skyward Mobile Access", click the button to install

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#### Chromebook Agreement & Optional Insurance Information

All Marcus Whitman students will be issued a Chromebook with the goals of:

- Increased opportunities for collaboration, communication and creativity
- Increased student engagement in a personalized learning environment
- Improved access to foster acquisition of knowledge and skills

The Chromebook is first and foremost an educational device. It is essential that this agreement be followed to ensure the safe, efficient, and ethical operation of these devices. SKSD retains sole right of possession of the Chromebook and related equipment (AC adapter, power cord and carrying case). There is no expectation of privacy in use or data stored on the district-owned device. The SKSD Acceptable Use policy is in effect.

#### Handling, Care & Use:

- You are always responsible for your own Chromebook.
- You should never share your personal login information, or let any other student use your Chromebook.
- Make sure you start each school day with a fully charged battery on your Chromebook.
- Handle the Chromebook with great care.
  - Do not throw, slide, drop, toss, etc. the Chromebook.
  - Do not carry or hold the Chromebook in the air by the screen/display.
  - Do not close the device with any items resting on the keyboard.
  - Do not store items in your case, it is meant to ONLY hold your device.
  - Always place your Chromebook into its protective case before moving to your next class.
- Your Chromebook should be used for school purposes only (no games, etc.)
- You should not eat or drink near your Chromebook.
- Heavy objects should never be placed or stacked on top of your Chromebook. This
  includes books, musical instruments, sports equipment, etc.
- Do not write on or decorate (no stickers) your Chromebook.
- Do not remove identification labels or tags placed on your Chromebook by district personnel.
- If your Chromebook is not working properly or needs repair, please notify Mrs. Chang immediately and bring it to the library at the first opportunity.

The district offers a Chromebook Protection plan. This plan is designed to alleviate the cost of repairing potential damage to the device. It covers accidental damage, not intentional damage. Damage caused by not following the handling, care and use directions, will result in

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the full cost to repair/replace damaged items, regardless of the purchase of the Chromebook Protection plan.

The plan in 2025-26 non-refundable cost will be \$30 per student for the current school year only. Students eligible for Free or Reduced-Price lunch will pay \$10 per student. To qualify for this reduced price, make sure you complete a <a href="School Benefits Application">School Benefits Application</a> and also the <a href="Annual Acknowledgement">Annual Acknowledgement</a> forms to insure your eligibility, prior to making the purchase. You can purchase at the student store or via <a href="SKSD Web Store">SKSD Web Store</a>. <a href="Enrollment must be completed within">Enrollment must be completed within</a> the first 30 days of school or within the first 30 days of new enrollment.

#### Coverage is as follows:

- The first accidental damage incident in a school year is covered at 100%.
- The second accidental damage incident in a school year is covered at 50%.
- Any additional damage in a school year is the student's responsibility for full cost of repair.
- Lost or stolen devices require a \$100 co-payment, which is refunded if the device is later found or recovered. (Subsequent loss/stolen requires a \$200 co-payment)

#### Minor Damage:

Please note any minor damage: scratches in the plastic, cracks in the plastic, scuffs on the screen, ink/paint stains, etc. If there are any cracks in the screen, damaged or missing keys, please bring the device to the library immediately.

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#### Hello Trailblazer Families!

Your student will be issued their school Chromebook on either September 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3rd, during their Science class. At the time, they will be shown a video about how to care for their device and be given their Chromebook Agreement to take home. Please be sure to check in with them on these days, and take time to read over, fill out and sign the agreement. In the agreement, it talks about the care of the device and the district's optional Chromebook Protection Plan. Below you will find a copy of the blank Chromebook Agreement, with the information about purchasing the optional Chromebook Protection Plan via the Webstore.
