Dear Academic Magnet High School,

This is the fourth and final summer Friday letter that you will get from me as we get ready to embark on the 2025-26 school year next week. If you have not already signed up to receive the weekly Raptor Report which is the electronic newsletter from our Partner In Education (PIE), you should definitely [do that HERE](#). That expertly done newsletter is a primary information avenue for our families during the school year.

In today's letter, we will cover buses (again), our 2025-26 Open House, student technology updates, our Student ID plan, AMHS Student Clubs, and our Class Canvas pages.

- School Bus Information- Last Friday's letter had attachments with the bus routes, stops, and times. Attached to this week's letter, you can find a [one-pager with helpful links](#) and Frequently Asked Transportation Questions. The [CCSD Transportation Page](#) has updated information as well as links to the [bus stop look-up tool](#) and the [school bus tracking app](#) that many of our families find useful. The Firstview Classic app was updated to Firstview 1.0 so if you have the Firstview Classic app on your phone from last year, you should delete it and [download the new one](#). This year's bus code is N6G3F. I know the anxiety that school transportation can cause, but our campus is dependent on the proficiency of school buses as the most efficient way to transport students to school. Given the size and the geographic complexity of our attendance area, we are really proud of our transportation program.
- Our 2025-26 AMHS Open House will be on Wednesday, August 20th 2025, from 5:15pm-7:30pm. There is a Save the Date flier attached. At that event, you will have the opportunity to meet your child's teachers, our school staff, and other families as you rotate through a very abbreviated version of your student's course schedule that evening.
- Two technology fliers are also attached. One has specific step by step directions for students to reset their school account password. The other is a FAQ document that answers questions about student emails, class link (the new Clever), and PowerSchool. Those fliers also have the contact information for Dr. Russell who is our schools knowledgeable and helpful technology liaison.
- At AMHS, student IDs have multiple functions from acting as a universal security measure to having scannable utility for item check-outs over the course of a school day. All students must wear their student ID when on campus. Students without an ID will be issued a temporary ID sticker four times before they are required to purchase (for \$5.00) a new hard ID with a lanyard and a case.
- The Club Fair is held over a few days lunch periods in the first week of September. During the annual Club Fair students can sign up and join any of our 60+ student clubs and organizations. These clubs vary widely based on student interest and serve to create and nurture meaningful connections between students at our school. If the past is predictive, we will have an exciting array of student-led clubs this year and encourage all students to explore the options for club membership during those lunch periods. We will share additional information about those opportunities in the weeks ahead.
- Each grade-level has a class Canvas page for students with dedicated oversight from an AMHS faculty member. Those pages have important reminders, information about service opportunities, and other relevant information for that specific grade level. Just as the Raptor Report serves as a primary information avenue for Magnet families during the school year, the class canvas page shares a lot of information with the primary audience of those grade level students.
