

Napa High School Intervention

Overview

Intervention is a dedicated time for students to review content each week to improve in areas yet to master. The intention is to provide students time during the school day to connect with their teachers, ask questions, and have time to finish their assignments. This time is a part of the school day where all students attend and participate in academic, college/career, wellness, enrichment-related activities.

Student attendance to activities during Intervention is mandatory. Attendance is taken at each activity and students are expected to sign-up for the following week's activity. Although students generally have a choice, teachers also have the ability to require students to attend their intervention activities. All requests and sign-ups happen through [Securly Flex](#).

FAQs

What if I forget to sign-up for an activity?

You will be automatically assigned to an activity with open spaces.

Can I go to a different classroom instead of where Flex says to go?

No. Students need to attend their assigned activity.

What if I'm all caught up with my classes?

Great! Sign-up for college/career or enrichment activities on Flex.

Can I go off-campus during Intervention?

No. School consequences will be issued for students found off campus/not attending their assigned activity.
