Personal Communication/Electronic Device Policy

#### PURPOSE

In the summer of 2025, Texas State Statute 1481 was passed to prohibit students' use of personal wireless communication devices (including cell phones) during the school day.

#### WHAT DEVICES ARE INCLUDED?



- CELL PHONES
- SMART WATCHES
- EARBUDS/AIRPODS
- HEADPHONES
- TABLETS/IPADS
- PERSONAL COMPUTERS
- SMART GLASSES

#### EXPECTATION

Devices are turned off and stored in your personal bag or locker during the school day until the time you leave.

\*Devices **MAY NOT** Be Stored in Clothing/Pockets.

#### AWAY FOR THE DAY

Refusal to comply with the Personal Communication/Electronic Device Policy will result in disciplinary consequences as outlined in the CFISD Code of Conduct.

#### Student Tardy Policy

A student is counted tardy if not in the classroom before the tardy bell rings for the period. Students who are excessively tardy will be assigned consequences that could include but are not limited to:

- Warning
- Parent contact/conference
- Student contract
- DHall (after-school detention)
- Loss of privileges
- DMC

Students will be marked tardy at the tardy station. Students that demonstrate a disregard for tardies and/or accumulate an excessive number of tardies, may also be referred to the assistant principal for intervention and/or consequence. If a student is more than 10 minutes late to a class period, the student will be referred to the assistant principal for intervention/discipline.

#### CLOSED CAMPUS | We are a closed campus

- Once on campus, students may not leave without parent/guardian permission (through Attendance Office) until 2:35 pm.
- Students must go to the AP office if they have an emergency.
- Only parents/guardians are allowed to bring food to students. Check in at front desk and leave the food with the receptionist.
- **WE DO NOT ACCEPT ANY DELIVERIES OF ITEMS (FOOD OR OTHERWISE) FOR STUDENTS (ex. Doordash, etc.).**
- ALL visitors must sign in at the front desk, provide driver's license, and get a picture ID badge (background check).  
**\*Unauthorized visitors will be ticketed for trespassing.**

#### Cypress Ridge - We DRESS for SUCCESS

(Reference the Student Handbook for comprehensive list)

##### All students must:

1. Wear student ID
2. ID picture must be visible
3. Use clear backpacks

##### Pants, Shorts, & Skirts

- Worn at waist, **NO SAGGING**, may not reveal underclothing
- Appropriate length – must be no shorter than fingertip in length with arms extended
- Rips or tears – must not be above fingertip length with arms extended

##### Shirts/Tops/Dresses

- May not reveal underclothing, midsection below the navel, torso, chest, breasts, cleavage, or back
- No spaghetti straps, strapless or halter tops

##### No inappropriate or offensive content or pictures on clothing or face masks

##### No pajamas that are onesies, lingerie, open-fly bottoms, robes

##### No slippers/house shoes

##### No head coverings, including hats, bandanas, hoodies/hoods *(exceptions made for religious/medical purposes)*

##### Tattoos – offensive/gang-related designs MUST be covered.

*Clothing that is deemed disruptive to the learning environment will be addressed.*

#### ALL STUDENTS are REQUIRED to wear SCHOOL ISSUED STUDENT ID

Students **MUST** have their IDs to purchase food in the cafeteria, ride the bus, enter class, and check-in at tardy sweep.

#### Temporary IDs = \$1.00 each CASH ONLY

*IF NO CASH, STUDENTS WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE ISSUED A PERMANENT BADGE FOR \$5 ADDED TO THEIR FEES.*

#### Permanent IDs = \$5.00 each

# In our efforts to ensure a safe and secure campus, students may be subject to a metal detector scan and/or an administrative search.

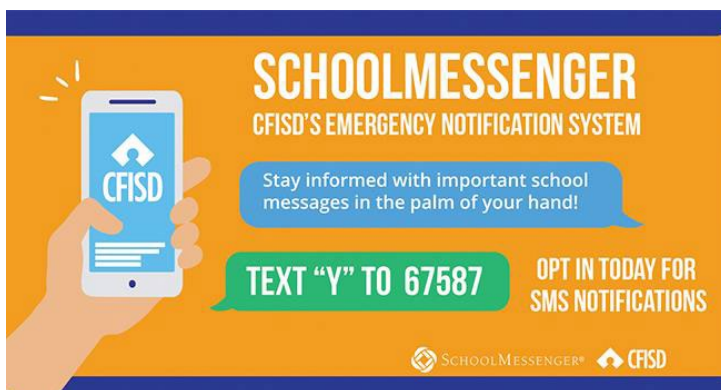


## Clinic

District Policy states that students are not allowed to carry or bring medication to school. **All medication must be brought in the original container to the clinic by a parent or adult.** Parents must fill out a permission form to administer medication in the clinic.

Inhalers and Epi-pens are allowed to be carried by students only after the Physician Self-Administration Medication form has been turned in to the nurse. A New Physician form must be turned in to the clinic at the beginning of each school year.

## Attendance

Consistent attendance is key to student learning. Attending school gives students the foundation they need for learning. If your student is absent from school, please send a note.

**ATTENDANCE OFFICE PHONE NUMBER: 281-807-8003**

- Upon returning to school, students have 3 days to bring their parent/guardian/doctor notes.
- An appropriate note must be received for an absence to be excused.
- Please note that **ALL absences**, even excused absences, count against **Attendance for Credit and final exam exemptions**, with the exception of Doctor Return notes, jury duty, military assignments, and approved College Days.
- **Release from school early:** Bring a signed note from parent/guardian to the Attendance Office with a valid phone number to verify the need to leave early.
- **Arrive late to school:** Sign in at the Attendance Office.
- For the safety of our campus, **we require parents to come inside, present an ID, and sign their student out from the Attendance Office** when picking up during the school day.
- Students with more than 10 absences may be summoned to court.

**STATE LAW REQUIRES STUDENTS TO ATTEND 90% OF A CLASS TO EARN CREDIT FOR IT.**
