If you were receiving a free or reduced lunch last year, you will have to reapply. Your free and reduced lunch status will be extended through September 4. After that, if you have not reapplied, it will end.

### **National School Lunch Program**

The National School Lunch Program is a program sponsored by the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Through this program, eligible students may be offered free or reduced-price meals. We also participate in the School Breakfast Program at most schools. Meal payments may be made online, as this program operates in all of the schools in the Kyrene School District. Meal application information is distributed and made available to every student in the district at the beginning of the school year. Application information will remain confidential and will be used only to determine eligibility for free or reduced-priced meals. Applications are also available at all school offices or by clicking on the meal application links.

Please visit [Linq Connect](#) to submit an online meal application to our district. You may turn in paper meal applications to any school office. We strongly encourage all families to apply. The free, reduced-price, and paid meal information is used to qualify the school district for other student qualifications and funding. You will receive an eligibility letter via email once your application has been processed that includes the status of your student(s) meal eligibility. **Big Bus News! Better Tracking Coming Soon.**

Attention Bus Riders! Kyrene School District will be launching a new and improved app for tracking your child’s bus route next school year. **Stopfinder** is an easy-to-use, all-in-one app that provides accurate information about bus routes and locations. You’ll be able to track your child’s bus, set up alerts for bus arrivals and departures, and communicate directly with the Kyrene Transportation team—all through the Stopfinder app. Kyrene will be sending additional information to all eligible bus riders in July.

Stopfinder can be downloaded for free from the App Store or Google Play, but please note that you won’t be able to use the app without an invitation to register from Kyrene. Those email invitations will be coming in July, before the start of the new school year. In the meantime, please log in to your ParentVUE account to verify your contact information is correct.


