Dear Parent or Legal Guardian:

William Byrd High School is pleased to announce that students can take the Virginia DMV learner's permit test online at the school. Students will be eligible to test if they are 15 years 6 months or older on the following date:

**Wednesday, November 25th at 3:30 PM in the WBHS Library**

**Steps to complete the process ·**

- Register for this test event at [https://vadmvexam.com/AT\\_Remote/ApplicantPortal/ApplicantPortal.aspx](https://vadmvexam.com/AT_Remote/ApplicantPortal/ApplicantPortal.aspx) (Internet Explorer 9 or higher or Safari).
  - A customer number is not required, but if you have a DMV ID card you must enter the name, DOB and customer number exactly as it appears on your DMV ID card. Otherwise, enter your full legal name and date of birth and leave the customer number field blank.
- Please provide a parent or student's email to receive registration confirmation, test results, notification of changes to the date and time or cancellation of the test event.
- Before taking the two part knowledge test, please STUDY the Driver's Manual located on DMV's web site using the following link: <http://www.dmv.virginia.gov/drivers/#manual.html>.

**On the test date please bring:**

- Completed, and signed DTS 41 consent form. The form is available at <http://www.dmvnow.com/webdoc/pdf/dts41.pdf> or from the driver education teacher. This form has been attached to this email as well.
- A picture ID to verify identity. If the student does not have a picture ID, take a picture, write the student's full legal name under the picture, and have a teacher sign to verify the student's identity. (We will take care of this if student goes to WBHS).
- The student will be issued a test receipt after passing the learner's permit test. Take this receipt to DMV to apply for the the learner's permit and to expedite the application process within 6 months or a retest is required.

**At the DMV customer service center:**

- the student must prove that they are 15 years and 6 months old
- pass a vision test
- provide DMV approved documents to prove residency and identity, [http://www.dmv.virginia.gov/drivers/#applying\\_learners.asp](http://www.dmv.virginia.gov/drivers/#applying_learners.asp)
- take a picture
- pay the fee for the learner's permit and driver's license.

Counselors will present information to all grade levels and meet with students individually to enter preliminary requests. We have designed this process, so you are able to see your student's course recommendations and selections as they make them.

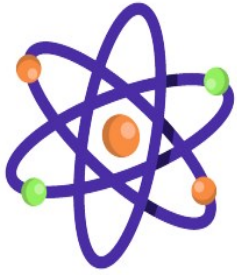
- By **November 18th** you can Log in to your Parent Vue and select COURSE REQUESTS. Scroll down and look for the COURSE REQUESTS option on the left.
- By **November 21st** you should be able to see teacher recommendations made by your student's teachers. They may have offered your student more than one option in a subject area such as Advanced Biology and Biology. Obviously, your student only needs one science class. When they meet with us, they can let us know their selection and we can make the changes. You can see it in your Parent Vue once selected.
- Talk to your students about course selections and elective options so they are prepared during registration.
- Once preliminary selections are made, you will have the opportunity to request changes including various levels by reaching out to your student's counselor.

These flags can be dropped off at the High School/NJROTC Classroom.

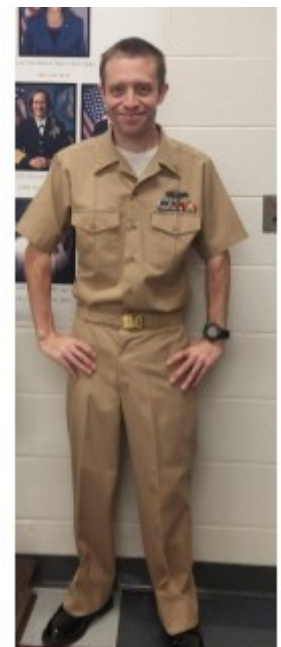
Our Navy JROTC team has been busy this year and continues to do magnificent work, here at school and in the surrounding community.

On November 1, 2024, Our Navy JROTC Color Guard participated at the NASCAR Craftsman Truck 400 Series at Martinsville, VA.

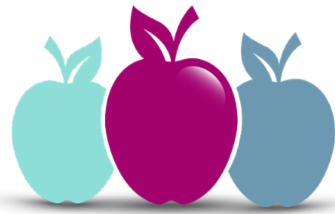


The Navy JROTC Program recently received a new teacher in October at William Byrd HS: Chief Petty Officer Michael Dixon (E-7).

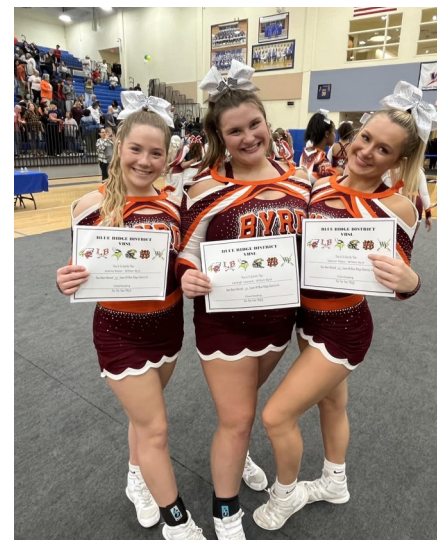

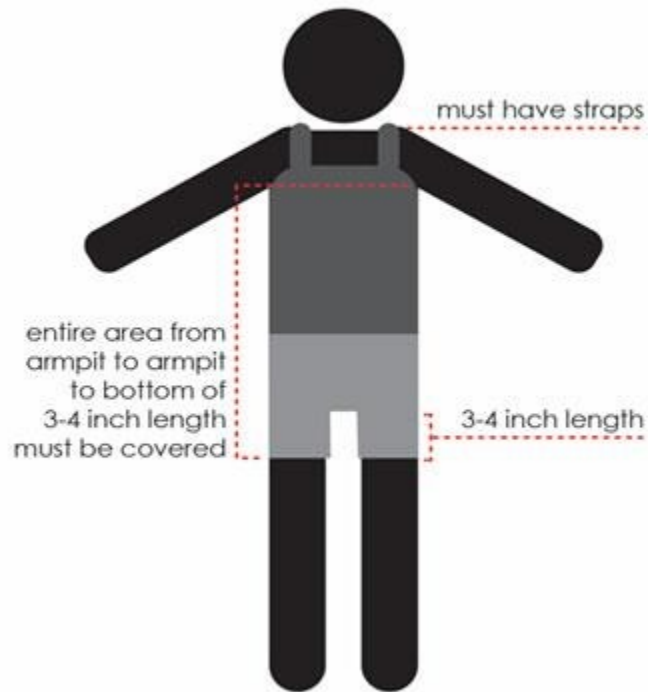
# STUDENT DRESS CODE

Roanoke County Public Schools respects students' rights to express themselves in the way they dress.

All students who attend Roanoke County Public Schools are also expected to respect the school community by dressing appropriately for a K-12 educational environment. Student attire should facilitate participation in learning as well as the health and safety of students and the adults that supervise them. This policy is intended to provide guidance for students, staff, and parents.

## Minimum Requirements:

1. Clothing must cover areas from one armpit across to the other armpit, down to approximately 3 to 4 inches in length on the upper thighs (see images below). Tops must have shoulder straps. Rips or tears in clothing should be lower than the 3 to 4 inches in length.
2. Shoes must be worn at all times and should be safe for the school environment (pajamas, bedroom shoes or slippers shall not be worn, except for school activities approved by the principal).
3. See-through or mesh garments must not be worn without appropriate coverage underneath that meet the minimum requirements of the dress code.
4. Headgear including hats, hoodies, and caps are not allowed unless permitted for religious, medical, or other reason by school administration.
5. Specialized courses may require specialized attire, such as sports uniforms or safety gear.



## Additional Requirements:

1. Clothing may not depict, imply, advertise, or advocate illegal, violent, or lewd conduct, weapons, or the use of alcohol, tobacco, marijuana or other controlled substances.
2. Clothing may not depict or imply pornography, nudity, or sexual acts.
3. Clothing may not display or imply vulgar, discriminatory, or obscene language or images.
4. Clothing may not state, imply, or depict hate speech/imagery targeting groups based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, religious affiliation, or any other protected classification.
5. Sunglasses may not be worn inside the building.
6. Clothing and accessories that endanger student or staff safety may not be worn.
7. Apparel, jewelry, accessories, tattoos, or manner of grooming that, by virtue of its color, arrangement, trademark or any other attribute, denotes membership in a gang that advocates illegal or disruptive behavior is prohibited.

*The administration at each school reserves the right to determine what constitutes appropriate dress.* Students who do not adhere to these guidelines will not be allowed to attend class. Parents will be called if appropriate clothing is not available or the student refuses dress-code appropriate clothing..

# Regional Registered Apprenticeship Program



## Overview

The Registered Apprenticeship program was designed in the 1930's by the Roosevelt administration. Originally designed as an adult job preparation program, it has expanded over the years to encompass over 15,000 jobs (as of July 2023) in a variety of businesses and industries and the Registered Apprenticeship (RA) program. Managed by Virginia Works (previously known as the Department of Labor and Industry (DOLI) in Virginia) the RA program offers a unique work-based learning model for 16-18-year-old students. Student participants in the RA program work towards credentials associated with each business through employment training and instruction. This is not an internship - apprentices are employed by the company. Once the student completes the program, they are eligible for a Journeyman's license. This license is a portable and widely recognized credential that indicates the student has relevant training and is on the path to becoming a master in their industry.

- § Student apprentices work approximately 20 hours per week.
- § RA positions require a minimum of 2000 on the job hours and 144 hours per year of industry-related instruction.
- § After high school graduation, the hours accumulated as a student apprentice transfer directly to the adult apprenticeship program.
- § Students receive school credit for their apprenticeship.
- § Student schedules will be arranged in a manner agreed upon by the student, parent, school system, and employer.
- § The Virginia Dept. of Education (VDOE) has developed guidelines for work-based learning (WBL) that is followed by the school system.

## Students

- § Attend Business Partner showcase and decide if RA program is the right fit for their goals and school class schedule
- § Attend the company tour/meeting scheduled with parent/guardian
- § Attend the interview/resume writing workshop scheduled within your school division
- § Create your resume and submit your application
- § Respond to correspondence from business(s) or school division via email or text
- § Promptly attend interview if/when scheduled
- § If hired, contact your school counselor to review and adjust your schedule for the upcoming school year
- § Attend/participate in RA Signing Day

## Timeline for Registered Apprenticeship (RA) Program Fall 2024 through Spring 2025

**Now-December 2024** - Companies Register with Virginia Works and let school system(s) know how many apprentices they anticipate taking and in what occupational area(s)

**January 2025** (prior to Showcase) - Companies participate in a 15-minute virtual presentation about what to expect at each point of the timeline.

**Jan. 23, 2025** (snow date of Feb. 4, 2025) - 5:30-7:30pm Berglund Center -Special Events Center (light refreshments to be served) Regional RA Sponsor Showcase-sponsor videos posted to the RCPS CTE website

**By February 28, 2025** Sponsor companies conduct parent/student information meetings at their choice of dates/times. Students should apply to selected companies following information meeting(s)

**By March 21, 2025** - Sponsor companies conduct interviews of students

Following March 21, 2025 - deadline - Companies participate in a 15-minute virtual presentation about next steps

**By April 11, 2025** - Deadline for Sponsor companies to notify students/parents and schools of selections

**By May 2, 2025** - School counseling staff work with student schedules to maximize time for students at their sponsor business. Planning should consider the company's needs. This check is also used to ensure selected students are on track to graduate.

**Friday, May 2, 2025** - Registered Apprenticeship Signing Day event at Salem Red Sox game - Carilion Clinic Field at Salem Memorial Ballpark
