Requests for reduction or waiver fees are via the school principal.

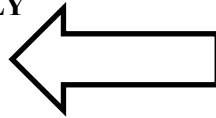

STUDENT PARKING PASSES

To obtain a parking permit for the 2025- 2026 school year, students need to have a valid driver's license, pay \$40 (cash, check, or through SchoolCashOnline.com), and complete the required Virginia Department of Education form. The form can be picked up in the front office or found online at www.doe.virginia.gov by searching for parking pass application. Students will be allowed to park on campus without a permit until Friday, August 22nd, in spots numbered 155 through 404. Starting on Monday, August 25th, all cars must display a current 2025-2026 school year parking permit in the front windshield. All students may purchase a permit on July 24th during our business day. Permits will be distributed to students through their A1 or B2 classes or the front office. Starting this year, seniors will be assigned a numbered spot, while underclassmen will be on a first-come, first-served basis in spots 219-404.

Roanoke County Public Schools offers online payment for student fees. We are excited to announce the availability of **Key School Solution's SchoolCash Online**. Payment by cash and check may be made at each school.

Register

Registering for your free SchoolCash Online account takes less than two minutes.

1. Visit <https://roanokecounty.schoolcashionline.com/> and click Register.
 - a. Type your first name, last name, and email address, and create a password.
 - b. Select a security question.
 - c. Select YES to receive email notifications. **You will not receive any marketing emails.** Selecting YES enables the system to send you fee notifications.
2. SchoolCash Online will send you a confirmation email. If you do not receive it, check your Spam folder.
3. Use your email address and password to log in.

How to add students to your account

1. Sign in to SchoolCash Online: <https://roanokecounty.schoolcashionline.com/>
2. At the top of the page, navigate to MY ACCOUNT.
3. From the dropdown menu, select My Students.
4. Click to add a student:
 - a. Type in your School Board Name.
 - b. Select your school's name from the list.
 - c. Enter student details. The system is fully secure, with PCI certification.
 - d. Click Confirm.
5. You may add up to eight students on your profile.

How to make a payment

1. You will be able to view any available items attached to your students that are set up on your account. You will also be able to view any public items that are available, but not necessarily attached to specific students.
2. Select the item which you would like to purchase and click "Add to Cart."
3. Once you have finished adding items to your cart, select "Check Out" to make a payment.

Attendance Procedures

*Refer to RCPS policy for Excused Absences and Tardies

To notify the school of an absence, you may call 562-3700 ext. 24008 and leave a voice message with the students name, grade and reason for absence. PLEASE NOTE THAT THE PHONE CALL DOES NOT EXCUSE THE ABSENCE! The call lets us know you are aware of your child's absence and prevents us from calling you. A written acceptable excuse (in compliance with RCPS policy) must be submitted to the attendance office when the student returns to school.

CHECK OUT PROCEDURES

We prefer students not be checked out of school per a phone call. In order to check your student out, you must use one of the following options:

- 1) Send a written note to the school with the student that indicates the student name, reason for check out and the time to be dismissed along with the parent/guardian's contact number and signature. The note should be turned in to the attendance office when the student arrives at school. At that time, a check out pass will be issued that allows the student to leave at the designated time.
- 2) Send an email to wbhsattendance@rcps.us that includes the information in bullet #1.
- 3) Send a fax to 540-890-7568 that includes the information in bullet #1.
- 4) Call the attendance office 540 890-3090 ext. 24008.
- 5) An authorized emergency contact may come to the school with a PHOTO ID and sign the student out at the attendance window. Only persons listed on the student's emergency card will be allowed to sign the student out.

COLLEGE VISITS/OUT OF TOWN TRIPS

A minimum of two days prior written notice must be submitted to the attendance office for college visits or out of town trips to be considered excused. Once submitted, the student will be issued a Prior Notice Form that must be signed by all teachers and returned to the attendance office prior to the absence. Failure to follow these procedures will result in the absence(s) being unexcused.

Annual Verification (ANVER) formerly Student First Day Online Forms

First day school forms must be completed online using Annual Verification (ANVER) which is accessed through your ParentVUE account. Parents will receive an alert on July 17th to log into their ParentVUE account to complete the Annual Verification for their children. In order for your child to receive their laptop these forms must be completed.

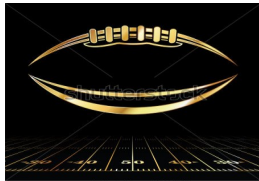
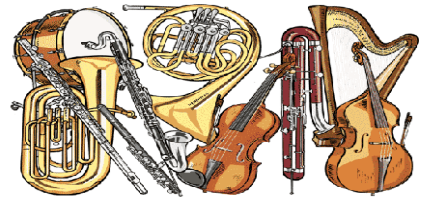
