



"Art Club Fall Semester 2025"

It is now time for students in **"5th through 8th grade"** to consider joining the **"Art Club"** for the *Fall Semester*. This is an after school club **open to boys or girls** who enjoy making a variety of challenging creative art projects. We meet in the Art Room #204 on Monday's right after school until 5:00 P.M. All classes held during normal "open" school days through the semester. The cost is \$225.00 per semester-for 10 classes. The first class is Monday, September 8th and the last class is Monday December 1st. I will host our "Ice Cream and Treats Party" on November 10th due to 5th grade trip! ***No class on 09/22/25 as I am out of town for a wedding.*** I will also hold a make-up day on Monday December 1st due to 8th and 5th grade trips as will miss a class. All payments in Cash or Check must be made out to **"Ronda Stieber not St. JPII - due in full with the registration form to secure a spot.** Note: limited enrollment for a fun, safe, creative environment.

All Students are encouraged to bring Water only and Snack then report to the Art Room right after school. I will prepare set up of the classroom at 3:15 and class begins promptly once set up and as middle school arrives.

Students will be walked down to carpool promptly at 5:00 P.M. Please pick up your child on time. Students who have not been picked up by 5:15 P.M. may be charged late fees according to the Parent/Student Handbook. If a student needs to leave earlier, parents may come to the front office for your child to be called down.

The Planned Spring projects are:

1) Acrylic Painting of a Colorful Georgia O'Keefe-Impressionistic Flower- Students will learn to paint in an Impressionistic style a large flower on an 11X 14" canvas using a system of color application that layers the colors with brush strokes applied in a pattern. Each class time new color tones will be introduced in the layering process until finished.

2)Aluminum Metal Molding - Students will use pre-cut 9" X 12" aluminum and use a template to draw with molding tools, a metal Cross Design. A variety of flower design will be offered to add around the Cross to draw. Next, students will learn molding techniques to stretch the metal so becomes a two-dimensional form. Then they will begin the flower design. This will be matted on black in 11 X 14 size. It can be displayed alone or placed in a "shadow box" purchased at Michaels Craft Store.

...Enrollment is limited - Intensified art techniques/tool usage are taught. Positive class behaviors are required!
