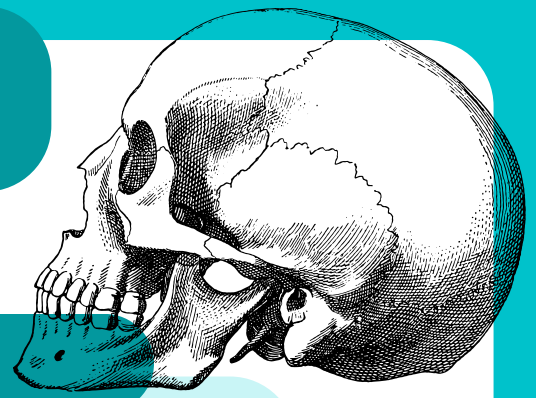

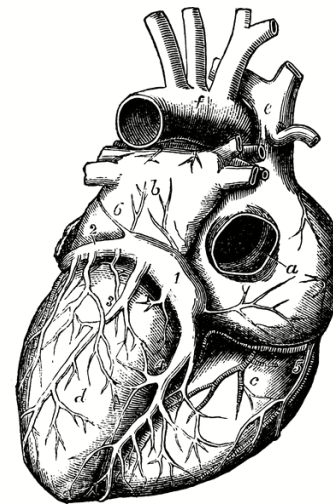
Classroom Rules and Procedures

Each student is expected to adhere to the Claiborne High School's Handbook and the Claiborne County Schools' Code of Conduct.

Course Description:

Attendance and Tardies:
