The Board further approves the Project Description Booklet in substantially the form presented, subject to such non-substantive changes as are directed by the Department of Education, and directs its architects and the appropriate officers and administrators to advertise the Notice of Public Hearing, make the Project Description Booklet available to the public and the news media, conduct the public hearing, and make all required submissions to the Department of Education, and further directs the appropriate officers, administrators, architects, construction managers, financial advisors and legal counsel to take all such other actions necessary and proper for carrying out the Act 34 Resolution. The final Project Description Booklet will be attached to the minutes of this meeting after approval on September 15.
