# **Helpful Tips and Reminders**

For some of you, this will be your first year at Taft, and some of you will be returning. Below are some tips, reminders, and protocols that will help you and your child have a successful start to the school year.

- All students will have a homework organizer that they can take back and forth from school.
  Please check this nightly to stay informed about homework assignments, upcoming tests,
  and other special events. Helping your child clean out their folder, once a week, is
  encouraged.
- Parent Square is replacing Bloomz and will be a valuable communication tool.
- Parents are encouraged to use ProgressBook to check their students' grades and progress. If you need help with this, please reach out to your child's classroom teacher or the Taft Secretaries.
- Please call the Taft office (not the classroom teacher) before 9:00 a.m. to report your student absent.
- If you are changing the way your child is going home, please notify the office secretaries (not the classroom teachers) before 2:30 p.m.
- Mr. Lilley is our school liaison, and Mrs. Ellis is our school counselor. They are available to support your child and can help connect you with resources.
- All contact information should be changed in Final Forms.

#### **Arrival and Dismissal Times**

8:30 a.m. Doors open

**8:40 a.m.** Students are considered tardy and must be signed in at the office

**2:30 p.m.** All changes to how your child is going home should be made to the office

**3:17 p.m.** Car Riders dismissal begins (car rider line only- see note under walkers)

3:25 p.m. Walkers are dismissed

\*Bus times vary based on the route

Do <u>NOT</u> stop in the road to drop off or pick up your child. Please use designated parking areas and lines at <u>ALL</u> times.





- If you are using the car rider line in the morning or the afternoon, please pull in and form two lines. This allows more cars to enter the lot.
- Please call the Taft office (not the classroom teacher) before 9:00 a.m. to report your student absent.
- If you are changing the way your child is going home, please notify the office secretaries (not the classroom teachers) before 2:30 p.m.

#### • Morning Car-Rider Line:

- Form two lanes when pulling into the lot. The two lanes will merge into one lane, marked by a sign.
- Students are asked to stay in the car until a staff member is in the parking lot to signal their child to exit (8:30 a.m.). Once students are given the thumbs up to exit their car and the flow of traffic begins, your child can exit the car once you're next to the building. They are asked to walk on the left side of the white painted line for their safety.
- We ask that ALL cars <u>pull up to the start of the white fence or pull forward until</u> <u>stopped before their child exits the vehicle</u>. This helps keep the flow moving quickly and allows more students to unload at a time.

#### • Afternoon Car-Rider Line:

- Form two lanes when pulling into the lot, but unlike in the morning, the lanes do NOT merge in the afternoon. Lanes pull forward until stopped.
- Car Riders will be dismissed at 3:17

#### Walkers:

- Students who are dropped off or picked up using the Dollar Tree parking lot are considered walkers.
- o All walkers will arrive and be dismissed through the Smith Road door.
- If you are dropping your child off at the Dollar Tree or your child is walking to school, please keep in mind that there is no supervision until 8:20. Students are asked not to arrive before this time.
- Safety Patrol members will be at this crosswalk to assist in safe crossings. Please have your child wait to cross until a Safety Patrol member is present.
- Students should cross at designated crosswalks ONLY.
- Walkers will be dismissed at 3:25
- Do <u>NOT</u> stop in the road to drop off or pick up your child. Please use designated parking areas and lines at <u>ALL</u> times.
