In such instances that a current school employee is hired to fulfill a NEOPA substitute position, that employee will be paid his or her regular rate of pay, or Level D, Step 1, whichever is higher (see Article 45.80)

Existing employees working in a higher classification for a day or more will be paid the higher rate of pay beginning on the first day of such assignment. (See Article 45.90.)

Steps 10, 12 and 15 are considered longevity steps. (See Article 44.40.3.2)
