

Prohibition of Personal Electronic Devices State Proviso 1.103

Where can Academic Magnet students keep their phones during the school day?

- Turned off and in your locked car (Junior & Senior Drivers)
- Turned completely off (not just vibrate or silent) and locked in your assigned locker. ***Preferred***
- Turned completely off (not just vibrate or silent) and in your bookbag.

Note: We will discontinue use of the teacher managed systems (the shoe rack, the teacher collection boxes, etc.) that some AMHS teachers have in place in individual classrooms.

The infraction code is 330 - Cell Phone. Teachers and staff will enter the student information into Review 360 and our administrators will follow up with the student.
