Here is what we are working on in our subject areas:

READING: Using a text about the Revolutionary War, we will examine text features. We will also look at the different causes of the war and its effects.

MATH (ON/ADV): We are working with larger numbers and using place value understanding to round multi-digit whole numbers.

MATH (ACC): We will describe & and represent the volume of a rectangular prism as the product of the number of cubes in one layer and the number of layers.

ELA: We will review how to identify sentences vs. fragments. We will begin to examine what is needed to create a piece of argumentative writing.

SOCIAL STUDIES: We will trace the events that shaped the revolutionary movement in America.
