Principals Corner

Parents/Guardians in the Marion County School District have the right to learn about the following qualifications of their child's teacher: State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas for your child's teacher, if your child's teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which the State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived, and if your child's teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher. You may also request the qualifications of an instructional paraprofessional who serves your student in a Title I program or if your school operates a schoolwide Title I program. Parents/Guardians may request this information from the Office of the Superintendent by calling 843-423-1811 or by sending a letter of request to the Office of the Superintendent, 719 North Main Street, Marion, SC 29571. The Marion County School District ensures that parents will be notified in writing if their child has been assigned, or has been taught by a teacher for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who does not meet applicable State certification or licensure requirements at the grade level and subject level area in which the teacher has been assigned.
