



2025 Board Election Notice Special Election

Carolina Voyager Charter School is working with the Public Charter School Alliance of South Carolina (PCSASC) to hold this year's election, ensuring integrity and confidentiality.

The governing board consists of nine (9) members: four (4) appointed members and five (5) elected members. One (1) seat is open in this election to fill a vacancy. The term for this seat will run through June 30, 2026.

August 8, 2025: The school will distribute a Call for Board Candidates to the public. Each prospective board member must complete an online filing form.

August 29, 2025: The filing period ends. Acceptance of candidates will be closed at **12:00 pm (Noon)**.

September 2, 2025: Candidate profiles shared online.

September 9-11, 2025: Voting open with e-ballot links emailed to each Carolina Voyager Charter School parent/guardian and employee. Voting opens on **September 9** at **8:00 am** and will close on **September 11** at **4:00 pm**. There is one vote per child enrolled in the school and one vote per employee. Each ballot will have a unique PIN to ensure the confidentiality and integrity of the process.

September 12, 2025: No later than this date, election results will be certified and announced publicly. School board members will be announced publicly.

September 16, 2025: Newly elected board members will take office and be formally sworn in at the first regularly scheduled board meeting. This will complete the election process.

Meeting and Training Requirements:

Carolina Voyager Charter School Board Members are required to attend all board meetings.

Mandated Board Training—Per state law, all board members are required to attend board training within one year of being elected. The South Carolina Department of Education will offer free training.
