

CALCULATORS FOR HIGH SCHOOL MATHEMATICS CLASSES

All High School students at Lincoln are required to have a graphing calculator for mathematics class.

The High School Mathematics Department recommends that you purchase the TI-Nspire CX (non-CAS), TI-Nspire CX II (non-CAS), or the TI-Nspire CX II-T (non-CAS) calculator as these are allowed on most tests.

These calculators all come with software for a PC or Mac with a code in the packaging, so be sure not to throw it away.

There are many other models of graphing calculators available, but only the TI-Nspire and the TI-84 Plus calculators will be supported in class. If buying another brand or model, be very careful that it is a model that is permitted at school and in external exams.

Note: the **TI-89** and the **TI-Nspire CX CAS** calculators are **not** permitted on the IB exams or at school.

The TI-Nspire calculators are not readily available for purchase in Argentina. They can be purchased overseas and a few calculators, the TI-Nspire CX II model, are available for loan from the Mathematics Department.
