This letter is to inform you of how to find your child's teacher placement, upcoming Foxview events, and important reminders regarding the 2025-2026 school year. Please keep in mind that **placement is subject to change with enrollment.**

To view your student's placement please log into the Parent Portal. The schedule will be viewable when clicking on the Schedule tab on the left-side navigation column.

Your child's homeroom teacher is listed as WORKSHOP on the class schedule. Workshop teachers teach either ELA and Social Studies, or Math and Science. The "SWITCH" teacher is the teacher with the subjects not assigned to the homeroom teacher. In addition, your Performance Music selection is noted on the schedule. If the student placement is blank, we are waiting to place him/her and will be directly in touch with you when that is complete.

August 21st Picture Day and Meet Your Teacher

The District's Annual Online Registration MUST BE COMPLETED by all De Pere families before this date. If you have not completed this step, you will have the opportunity to complete it at Foxview before you proceed through Picture/MYT Day.

- Pay your School Fees online. If you do not wish to take advantage of this service, school fees will be
 accepted during the Picture/MYT Day. Please make checks payable to U.S.D.D. for \$11.50.
- A full school supply list is available on our website, https://foxview.deperek12.org/families/supply-lists, and at many local stores.
- The first day of school is Thursday, August 28th.
- The **6**th **Grade bell** to enter school rings at <u>7:47 AM</u>, with students needing to be in their classroom by 7:55 AM. The day ends at 2:55 PM. Please do not drop off children before 7:30 AM, as we do not have playground supervision until this time.
- The 5th **Grade bell** to enter school rings at <u>7:49 AM</u>, with students needing to be in their classroom by 7:55 AM. The day ends at 2:55 PM. Please do not drop off children before 7:30 AM, as we do not have playground supervision until this time.
- On the first day of school, all students on the first floor (homeroom # begins with a 1) should enter at the main entrance door #1 and proceed to their homeroom. Students on the second floor (homeroom # begins with a 2) should enter at the classroom wing door #2 near the playground.
- There will be a crossing guard located at the corners of Michigan and Bolles, and at Michigan and Merrill.
- If you have a question about busing, please call Lamers Bus Company at 336-5264.
- The playground/parking lot area in front of the school is closed to traffic and parking on school days, between the hours of 7:15 AM and 3:15 PM.
- Our north-side parking lot is for staff parking only. For the safety of the students, please do not use the staff parking lot for pick-ups and drop-offs.
- USDD participates in the National School Breakfast and National School Lunch Programs. In addition to standard meal options, Foxview will offer some ala carte items along with extra entrees for purchase. Money will need to be deposited into the students' lunch accounts via the Parent Portal for online payments, or checks written out to USDD can be dropped off on Picture/Meet Your Day.
