Parking Lot Safety Reminders

Thank you for helping us keep the parking lot safe for the drivers and pedestrians by doing the following:

- When in the front parking lot, student drop off is at the front of the school. Always drive as far forward as possible before stopping to drop off your student. This keeps the line moving.
- Quickly drop off. Have backpacks, instruments, and projects ready before you arrive at the curb to keep things moving quickly.
- Use Designated Crosswalks. Students must cross only at marked crosswalks.
- Follow Staff Directions. Our staff is there to guide traffic for safety; please follow their instructions at all times.
- Be aware when walking in the parking lot. Stay off of your device.
- Drive slowly and watch for pedestrians.



Let's Talk About It!

Open, honest conversations with your teen will help build trust, strengthen your relationship, and prepare them to navigate life's challenges with confidence. This week take some time to talk to your teen about the dangers of drugs.

Please review the information below sent to all LUSD families from Superintendent Dextraze:

We want to take a moment to address a growing concern affecting communities across the nation, including here in our region — the presence of dangerous substances, particularly fentanyl.

Fentanyl is an extremely powerful synthetic opioid. Even a very small amount can be life-threatening, and it is often mixed into other substances without the user's knowledge. It can appear in many forms, including pills, powders, and other drugs that may look harmless.

We are asking all parents and guardians to take some time to have an open, age-appropriate conversation with your child about the dangers of any unknown or unprescribed substance. Please remind them:

- Never accept or take any pills, powders, or other substances from anyone.
- Only take medication that is prescribed to them and provided by a trusted adult.
- If they see something unsafe, they should tell a staff member or trusted adult immediately.

Together, through awareness and open communication, we can help keep our students safe. If you have questions or need resources on how to talk to your child about this issue, please contact the school office.

ATHLETIC CLEARANCE STEPS

- Students can participate in only one sport at a time. In order to participate in conditioning or season of play, students must be cleared through Athletics.
- Students need to be cleared through the Athletic Department EVERY year.

IMPORTANT: ALL ITEMS NEED TO BE UPLOADED TO THE STUDENTS HOME CAMPUS ACCOUNT BEFORE ATTENDING OR PARTICIPATING IN CONDITIONING OR TRYOUTS.

- Go to <u>Homecampus.com</u> to create an account (You will need to print the Confirmation Message (last page) showing an account has been set up)
- 2. Physical completed within a year and signed by doctor
- 3. Random Drug Testing Agreement signed by student and parent
- 4. Upload all ALL documents to the home campus website.
- 5. <u>Email</u> Athletic Director at <u>bgray@lusd.net</u> to notify all documents were uploaded to the Home Campus website.

Clearance will be issued once <u>ALL</u> documents have been submitted online and reviewed by the Athletic Director. Clearance can take 24-48 hours.

Homeroom Information - Trojan Time

Handbook Highlights

Attendance/Tardies

- Regular and punctual attendance is expected and essential for students to succeed.
- Any student tardy for class will be assigned detention!

Cell Phone/Electronic Device Policy

Cell phones/smart watches/headphones and other unauthorized electronic devices are to be off and put away during class hours including time out of the classroom on a hall pass, and during <u>ALL</u> school and state tests. Students are required to turn their phones off and place them in the secured area designated by the teacher each class period. All other unauthorized electronic devices should not be brought to school.

Dress Code

This is a brief summary of the dress code. You can find more specific details in the LHS Student Handbook. Clothing must cover from armpit to armpit, include shoulder straps, and cover the midsection. Bottoms must fully cover undergarments and allow movement. Shoes are required and must be safe for school. See-through clothing must have appropriate coverage underneath. Some courses may require specific attire like uniforms or safety gear.

Schedule Change Requests

If a student has a compelling reason to request a schedule change, they must see their counselor at lunch or after school during the first 5 days of the semester with a signed Schedule Change Request Form. There is no guarantee a student's schedule will be changed. Students must attend their originally scheduled classes until a counselor confirms that a change has been made. Schedule

Off Campus Pass (Juniors & Seniors)

Attention families of juniors and seniors:

We will begin issuing off-campus lunch passes soon. Please make note of the following requirements below, and discuss these requirements with your students before signing the permission slip.

Lincoln High School students in grades 11 and 12 will be permitted to leave campus only if the following criteria are met:

- A GPA of 2.0 or greater in the most recent progress report/quarter, no F's
- No more than 7 unexcused (single period) absences
- No more than 10 tardies
- A signed parent/guardian permission slip
- No outstanding bills or fines
- No unserved Saturday Schools
