Dear Parents and Guardians,

At BES, we are dedicated to cultivating a growth mindset in every student. We believe that students thrive when their efforts and achievements are recognized, and we are committed to creating an environment that supports their academic and behavioral development.

This year, we will continue implementing the **Super Improver PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports)** system. Each student will begin at the **Beginner level** (white punch card). Students will earn a punch on their card each day they meet our school-wide expectations. Upon completing a card, the student will move to the next level and begin a new card, continuing their progress toward personal growth. Progress will be visible to students on the **Super Improver Wall** in their classrooms. After reaching each new level, students will receive a reward, which will be noted on the back of their completed punch card.

Please note that punches are not automatically given each day. Students must consistently meet behavioral expectations to earn a punch. We use **Class Dojo** as our behavior monitoring and communication platform. This system helps determine whether a student has met the daily criteria. Specifically:

- Students who receive **0–1 red points** on Class Dojo in a day will earn **1 punch**.
- Students who receive **2 or more red points** in a day will **not** receive a punch.

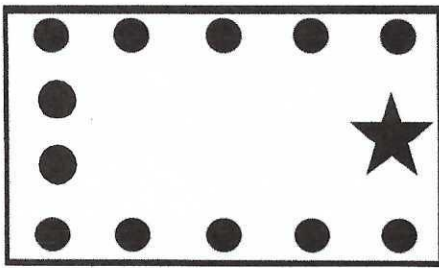
In the event that a student is **suspended from school**, they will not be eligible to participate in the **PBIS celebration** for that semester. However, they will still be able to continue working toward their individual Super Improver Card incentives as they level up.

In **December**, we will celebrate students who have met the punch card goal for the fall semester. For **Kindergarten through 2nd grade**, students must earn at least **80%** of the possible punches—**54 punches** between **August 18 and December 5, 2025**. Families of students who qualify for the celebration will be notified the week before the event.

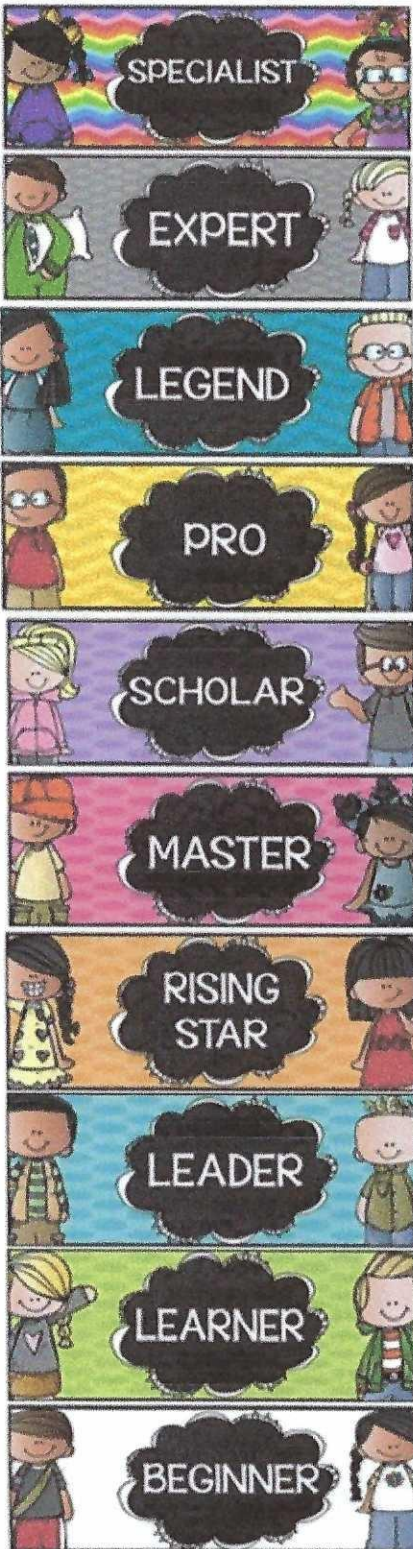
Information regarding spring semester goals and our **PBIS Water Day** will be shared in December.
