WELCOME EMAIL FROM SECURLY

Once you create a free PowerSchool family account and link it to your child, you'll automatically receive an email invitation to Securly Home. Be sure to check your spam or junk folder for an email from **noreply@securly.com** with the subject "**Welcome to Securly.**" if you don't see it within a day.

DOWNLOAD THE SECURLY HOME APP

Open the Google Play or Apple App Store and search for the Securly Home app and download it to your device. Links for each app store are posted here:

SETTING UP THE SECURLY HOME APP

- Open the Securly app and tap "Get started"
- Enter the email address that matches your **Welcome to Securly** email and tap "Get instant access"
- Tap "Enter code" and type in the the 6 digit code that was emailed to you.
- Swipe through the navigation steps and chose your notification preferences.

You now have access to powerful monitoring and management features for your student's device. In addition, Securly can provide weekly reports sent to your email inbox. Make sure to mark emails from **noreply@securely.com** as safe/trusted in your email inbox so you receive these reports.
