Late Work

20 points will be taken off for work turned in the day after it is due. An additional 10 points will be subtracted each following day up to 50 points. 10 points are deducted for work turned in the day it's due, but after the time it's due. Late work needs to be turned into the teacher, not placed in the tray.

Detention

If detention is assigned, students will be expected to be in my classroom at 7:30 the next morning. During detention, students will clean lab equipment, the classroom, or complete other duties assigned by me. Failure to attend or work during detention will result in 2 days of detention. If missed again, a discipline referral will be turned in.

Hall Passes

Every 6 weeks students will be given 2 "Migl Hall Passes".
